

Applications for absentee ballots may be obtained at the office of the District Clerk at the Middle/High School building at 5935 Route 60, Sinclairville, New York 14782 between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM prevailing time. Completed applications must be received by the District Clerk at least seven (7) days before the District Vote (May 11), if the ballot is to be mailed to the voter, or on the day before the District Vote (May 17), if the ballot is to be delivered personally to the voter.

A list of all persons to whom absentee ballots have been issued will be available for inspection in the office of the District Clerk, where it shall be open for inspection by any qualified voter of the District between the hours of 8:00 AM and 4:00 PM prevailing time, on each of the five (5) days prior to the day of the District Vote (except for Saturdays, Sundays, and holidays), and said list will be posted at the polling place at the election. No absentee ballot will be canvassed and counted unless it is received in the office of the District Clerk prior to 5:00 PM prevailing time on May 18, 2021.

Military voters who are qualified voters of the District may apply for a military ballot by requesting an application from the District Clerk. For a military voter to be issued a military ballot, the District Clerk must have received a valid ballot application no later than 5:00 PM on April 22, 2021. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, the military voter may indicate their preference for receiving the application or ballot by mail, facsimile transmission or electronic mail.

Once an application is received by the District Clerk, an official ballot will be mailed to the applicant.
