GBK GBK Suspension

The superintendent shall have the authority to suspend licensed

employees with pay pending further board action.

The superintendent may suspend licensed employees with pay for

any reason, including, but not limited to, one or more of the following:

alleged violation of board policy, rule or regulation; refusal or failure to

follow a reasonable directive of an administrator; the filing of a

complaint against the employee with any civil or criminal authority; the

alleged commission of an offense involving moral turpitude; or other good

cause.

If a suspension without pay is imposed on an employee, the

employee is entitled to pay until the employee has been advised of the

basis for suspension and has been given an opportunity to respond.
