The Board of Education recognizes that effective discipline, administered by parents, teachers and administrators is essential to education in our schools. All participants in the educational process have basic rights with responsibilities. Each student has the basic right to a quality educational program without interference, fear, harm or the disruptive behavior from another student. Because varieties of emotions and behavior exist in children and developing young adults, prescribed disciplinary actions may need to be adapted to a particular situation.

Students bear the final responsibility for their behavior and ultimate penalty for their misbehavior.
