BEING A TEAMMATE FOR BETTER RESULTS

A student demonstrates effective work within groups through interdependence, flexibility, and compromise to achieve a common goal.

Communicator

CLEAR AND CONCISE TO CONVEY THEIR PURPOSE

A student receives and presents information to effectively participate in interactions using appropriate means or methods.

Critical Thinker

ANALYZE, EVALUATE, SYNTHESIZE, INTERPRET TO PROBLEM SOLVE

A student demonstrates effective critical thinking by analyzing ideas, data, textual evidence, and/or objects to make inferences, draw conclusions, establish patterns, and/or solve problems

Creative Thinker

IMAGINES AND VISUALIZES NEW POSSIBILITES

A student demonstrates generation of original ideas or use of knowledge in new ways.

ANTICIPATE, MONITOR AND REFLECT ON NEEDS TO ACHIEVE GOALS

A student demonstrates responsibility for self and community through awareness, social responsibility, and engagement.

Conveying Your Purpose

BEING CLEAR AND CONCISE

Students clearly and concisely communicate to convey their purpose and ideas to meet the needs of the audience. Students accurately interpret, and appropriately respond to oral, written and visual Articulate thoughts and ideas effectively using oral, written, visual, and nonverbal communication skills in a variety of forms and contexts

- Craft messages that consider the audience's needs, preferences, and motivations
- Select the most appropriate media and technologies from a wide range for effective communication with various audiences
- Critically review, evaluate and adjust communication as necessary to ensure alignment with the audience, message, and purpose (inform, instruct, motivate, persuade)
- · Listen effectively to decipher meaning
