BEING A TEAMMATE FOR BETTER RESULTS

A student demonstrates effective work within groups through interdependence, flexibility, and compromise to achieve a common goal.

Communicator

CLEAR AND CONCISE TO CONVEY THEIR PURPOSE

A student receives and presents information to effectively participate in interactions using appropriate means or methods.

Critical Thinker

ANALYZE, EVALUATE, SYNTHESIZE, INTERPRET TO PROBLEM SOLVE

A student demonstrates effective critical thinking by analyzing ideas, data, textual evidence, and/or objects to make inferences, draw conclusions, establish patterns, and/or solve problems

Creative Thinker

IMAGINES AND VISUALIZES NEW POSSIBILITES

A student demonstrates generation of original ideas or use of knowledge in new ways.

Self-Directed

ANTICIPATE, MONITOR AND REFLECT ON NEEDS TO ACHIEVE GOALS

A student demonstrates responsibility for self and community through awareness, social responsibility, and engagement.

Solving Challenges & Problems

INTERPRETING, ANALYZING, EVALUATING

Students identify and consciously apply the type of thinking needed in a particular situation in order to solve a challenge or problem.

- Clearly and accurately define the problem to be addressed
- · Analyze and evaluate evidence, arguments, claims and beliefs
- Synthesize and make connections between information and arguments
- Interpret information and draw conclusions based on the best analysis
- Reflect critically on how the product and process can be improved once the solution has been developed

APPLYING KNOWLEDGE TO CREATE

- Students are collecting information, and evaluating the information by constructing a judgment of its relative merits
- Students analyze demographic statistics from their hometown and then use their understanding of population trends to develop a plan for an upcoming
- housing development project.
- Students apply their knowledge from their character analysis to create and develop their own characters;
