A student demonstrates generation of original ideas or use of knowledge in new ways.

## **Learning Everyday**

#### TAKING OWNERSHIP OF LEARNING

Students identify when gaps in their knowledge or skills require additional learning. Students use effective strategies to close the gap, assessing progress and taking additional action until goals are achieved.

- Set purpose for learning and identify success criteria
- Create and implement action plans to meet learning goals
- Anticipate challenges and reduce barriers to achieve goals
- Leverage multiple resources for learning (research, experts, media, networking)
- Monitor progress, ask questions, and seek help when needed
- Reflect critically on experiences, knowledge and skills to assess progress and adjust or set new goals
- Show persistence and celebrate success toward achieving learning goals

## SETTING CRITERIA AND FOLLOWING THROUGH TO COMPLETION

- Students are engaged in long-term activities in which they are required to plan the process of their work and improve it over multiple iterations.
- Students are planning the schedule and process of their work, and will follow this schedule and process to completion.
- Students have success criteria up front, and are required to seek and act on feedback.
