Dear Andover Families,

We are excited to announce that under the new CDC and NYS guidance we are able to bring **ALL** students back **ALL DAY EVERYDAY!** This change will take effect on April 26th, the first day of the fourth quarter. It is important to note that under the new guidance students will be required to wear masks all day while on campus. There will be two scheduled mask breaks throughout the day (one in the morning and one in the afternoon), however, the students will not need to wear them while eating lunch. We ask that you send your student(s) with two masks daily (over time masks get saturated/wet and are not as effective). In the event that your student(s) needs an additional mask, we have them available.

Student academic schedules will remain the same. We will be converting our gym into a cafeteria in order to accommodate both breakfast and lunch. Meals will continue to be delivered to those students who remain fully remote. Families will still have the option to remain fully remote or change to in-person instruction.
