Dear North Little Rock School District Parents, Guardians, and Caregivers,

The North Little Rock School District has partnered with Kavanaugh Pharmacy to provide a COVID-19 vaccination clinic for **students 16 years of age and above** who attend North Little Rock Academy, North Little Rock Center of Excellence, and North Little Rock High School. The students who participate will receive the Pfizer vaccine, which is the vaccine approved for this age group.

Consent forms must be completed and turned in before the vaccine is administered to any student. Consent forms are available at the school nurse's office or [at this link](#). Students must turn the form in **by Monday, April 26, 2021.**

The first dose will be administered on Wednesday, April 28, 2021. The second dose will be administered on Wednesday, May 19, 2021. The vaccination clinics will take place at both North Little Rock Academy and North Little Rock High School.

Since seniors will have graduated by the time of the administration of the second dose, they will be allowed back onto campus to receive it by showing their vaccine card upon entry. The first of the two dose series will be given to **students 16 Years of age and above with completed consents on April 28, 2021.**

Students need to have a copy of their insurance information and a photo identification at the time of the vaccination. All health insurances are accepted, including Medicaid or ARKids.
