*Plus one parent or guardian

The Genesee and Orleans County Health Department are hosting Pfizer COVID-19 Clinics. The links for these clinics are being sent out by superintendents to their youth as Pfizer is the only COVID-19 vaccine that is available to those **under 18 years of age**.

For this reason, we are holding a special invitation clinic for schools in our communities! These vaccine appointments are for high school students and **one** accompanying guardian. If you are under the age of 18 you must be accompanied by one parent or legal guardian (regardless if he/she is also getting vaccinated.)
