students.

Title I.A schools must meet certain obligations.

 As a parent, you are entitled to know how this money is currently being spent for all of our students and what is being planned for our school!



You are entitled to know.....

- The qualifications of those who teach your child.
- If your child has been assigned or taught for 4 or more consecutive weeks by a teacher who is not highly qualified.
- Whether your student's teacher is teaching under emergency or other provisional status through which State qualification has been waived.
- Whether your student's teacher is teaching in the field of discipline of the certification of the teacher.
- Whether your child is provided services by paraprofessionals and, if so, their qualifications.

Student Progress

 You have the right to review the school report card and student progress information, including the state academic assessments required under Title I.A.

Safe School

- You have the right to send your child to a safe school.
- You may change schools if your child:
 - Is a victim of a violent offense while still at school.
 - Is in a school that has continuing dangerous threats.
