This is a barrier to learning that we can change by simply having the funds to create the "Fresh Clothes-Fresh Minds" program at Cook County Schools-ISD 166. This program will be run by PE Instructor, Mrs. Kasha Hansen and School Social Worker, Mrs. Anna Sandstrom.

Our mission is to help reduce the students anxiety and fear over dirty clothes to increase their attendance and willingness to stay in school. We aim to do this in the following ways.

- 1) Wash clothes in the event of accidents. Students will be given another item of clothing while their clothes are washed and then they can swap out before they leave for the day.
- 2) Wash clothes for students that do not have access at home to increase their attendance and overall mental and physical well-being.
- 3) Teach students how to do laundry. Teaching them how to wash their own clothes will teach them a valuable life skill and boost their confidence.

Funding requested will be used for initial start up of the program to get it moving along. Additional funding needs will be requested through donations as they are needed.

A WISE grant of \$100 was awarded last year for clothing, but without having the option to clean the clothes we were replacing, the clothing supply does not stay filled.
