Mrs. Conforti- Thank you Mr. Fillpot. I am excited to see students returning


Mrs. Hurst- Sad to see Mr. Fillpot go and will remember all of the good things he has done for our district.

Mr. Snodderly- You did good! Write down plans for retirement in pencil as they can change quickly. Board is going to do a good job to fill superintendent position.


Mr. Wallace- Recognized Mr. Fillpot and staff. County meeting September 23 tentatively in person. CBSA Legislative Action Day
