Principal's Report: Dr. Jay Dostal:

Dr. Dostal reported that Virtual CAP Conferences will be held for 9th – 11th grade students February 22nd – 24th. All juniors will have individual conferences with counselors before the CAP Conference. Separate conferences will be held for rising 9th graders March 2nd – 19th. Parents can view the classes their students have chosen in the Home Access Center through February 26th. Dr. Dostal has reported higher attendance with virtual conferences than in person conferences.
