

Prom 2021: Ticket Sales & Reminders

We will be selling Prom Tickets in 3 stages this year. We want to make sure SENIORS get first priority! If you come to the table before it is your time, I will be sending you away -- don't be offended! :)

REMINDERS about Prom 2021:

- ONLY Seniors will be allowed to bring an Edgewood date (grades 9,10,11)
- We will be scheduling two Prom sessions; you will be asked which session you want to attend when you buy your ticket, so be ready!
- Once the 2nd session fills up to our capacity, you will only have the option of the 1st session
- Juniors cannot bring dates to Prom this year, even if they are an Edgewood student (sorry)
- NO outside guests are allowed as dates; this includes Edgewood graduates and students that attend other schools (sorry again)
- Seniors are allowed to buy their own ticket on the first two days and come back to buy their date's ticket later; however, please be aware that depending on numbers, you might be asked to switch your session. We want to make sure all SENIORS get the session they choose before you bring your date from another grade!

Prom Ticket Cost = \$25 -- Checks should be made to Edgewood City Schools

SCHEDULE for TICKET SALES DURING LUNCH at EHS:

Thursday, April 22nd - Friday, April 23rd = SENIORS ONLY (no dates)

Monday, April 26th - Tuesday, April 27th = SENIORS WITH DATES

Wednesday, April 28th - Thursday, April 29th = JUNIORS ONLY

Friday, April 30th = Anyone left! Last day for ticket sales!

FOR REMOTE/VIRTUAL ACADEMY AND BUTLER TECH STUDENTS: 2:00-3:00pm in the MAIN OFFICE

Thursday, April 22nd = SENIORS ONLY (no dates)

Monday, April 26th = SENIORS WITH DATES

Wednesday, April 28th = JUNIORS ONLY

Friday, April 30th = Anyone left! Last day for ticket sales!
