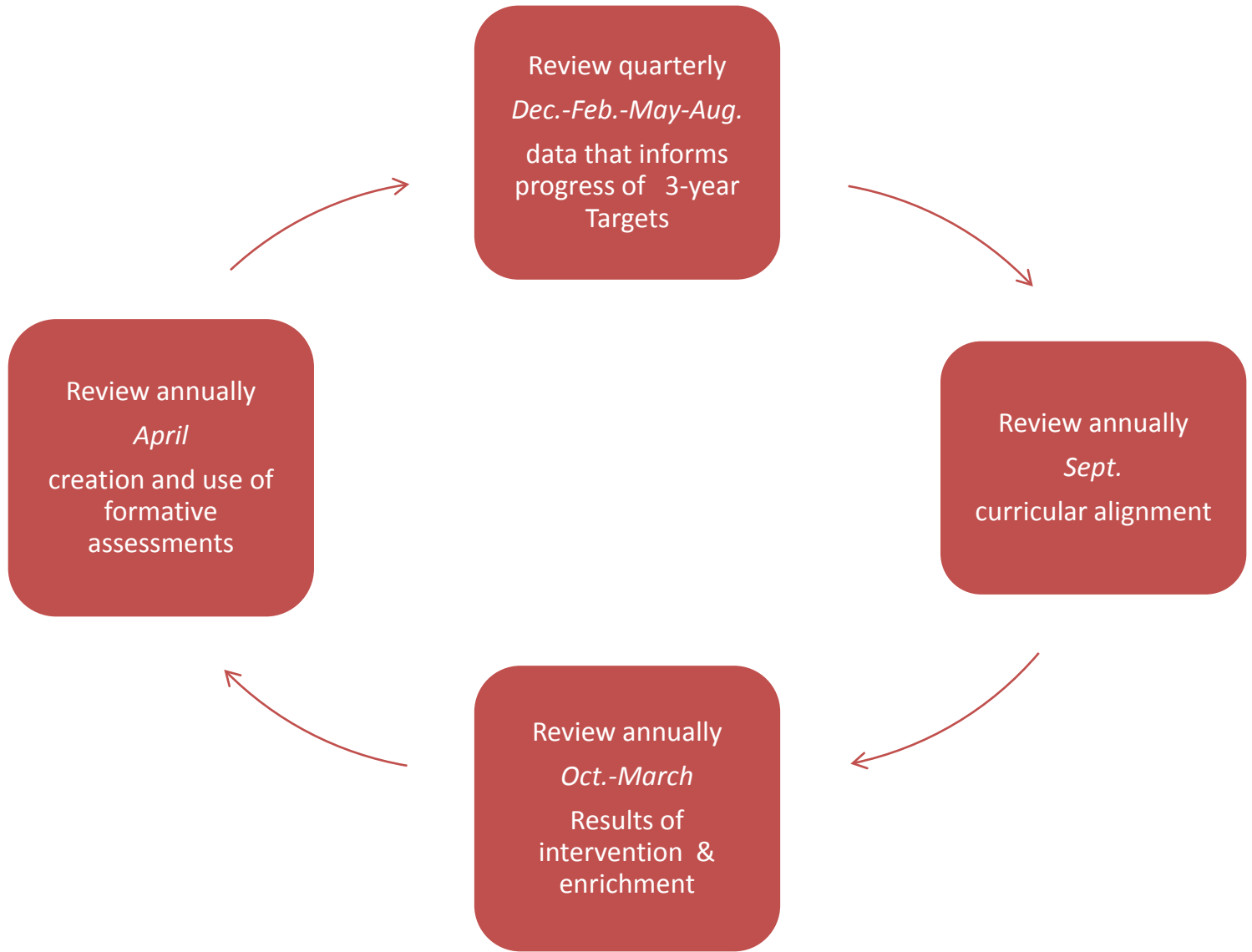

 - The district will expand the experiences K-6 students have to our interconnected world through inquiry and languages.

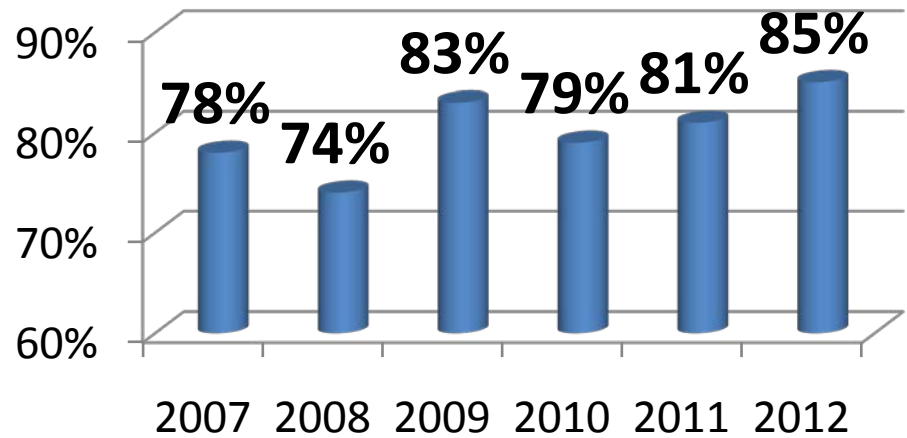
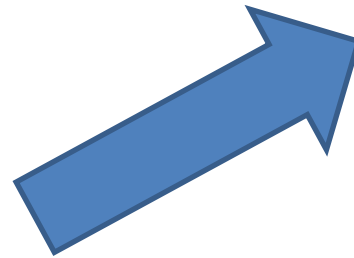

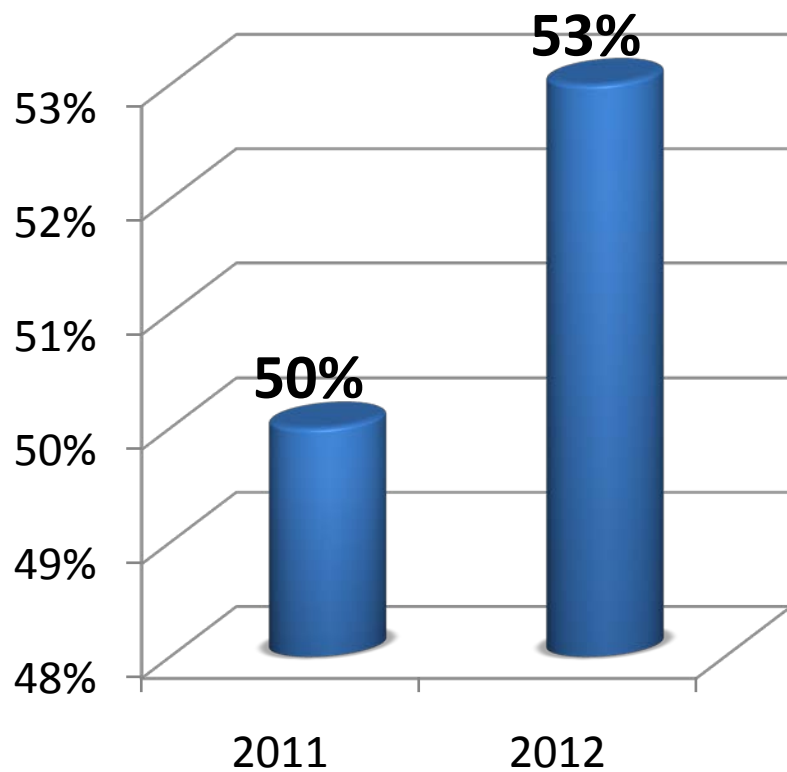

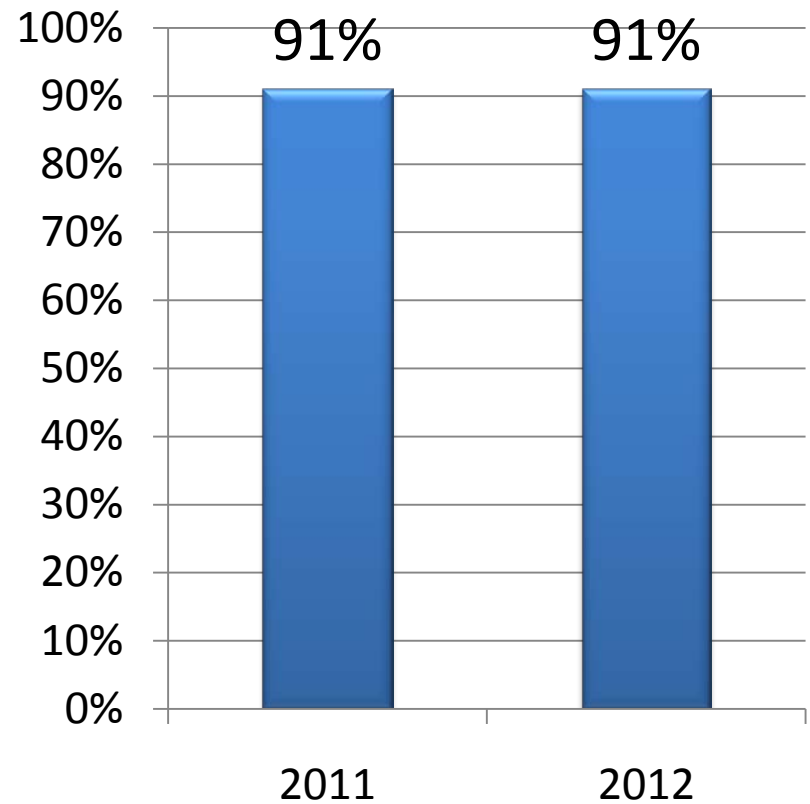


Mastery & Passing Rate Grades 5-12

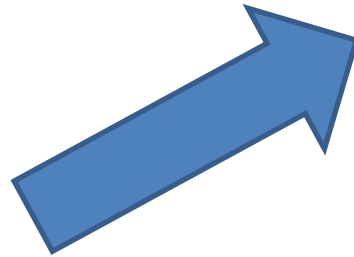
K-4 Reading Rate

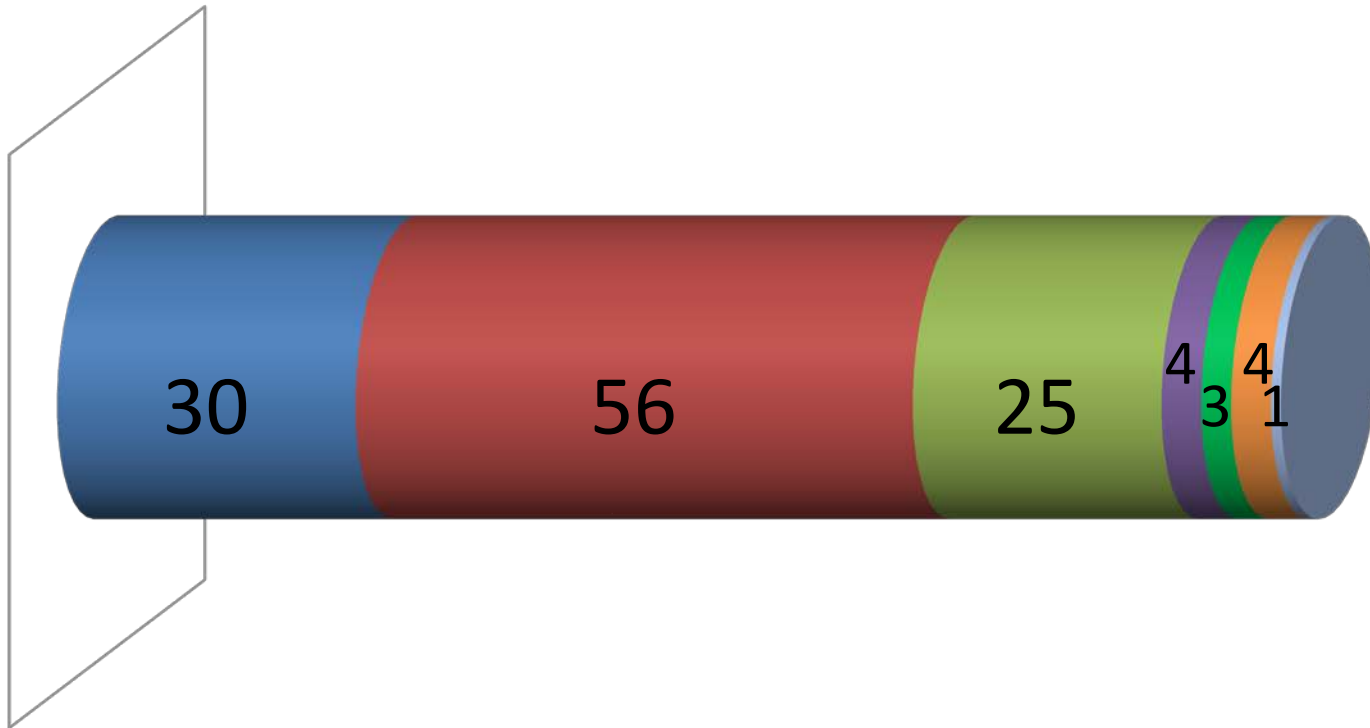

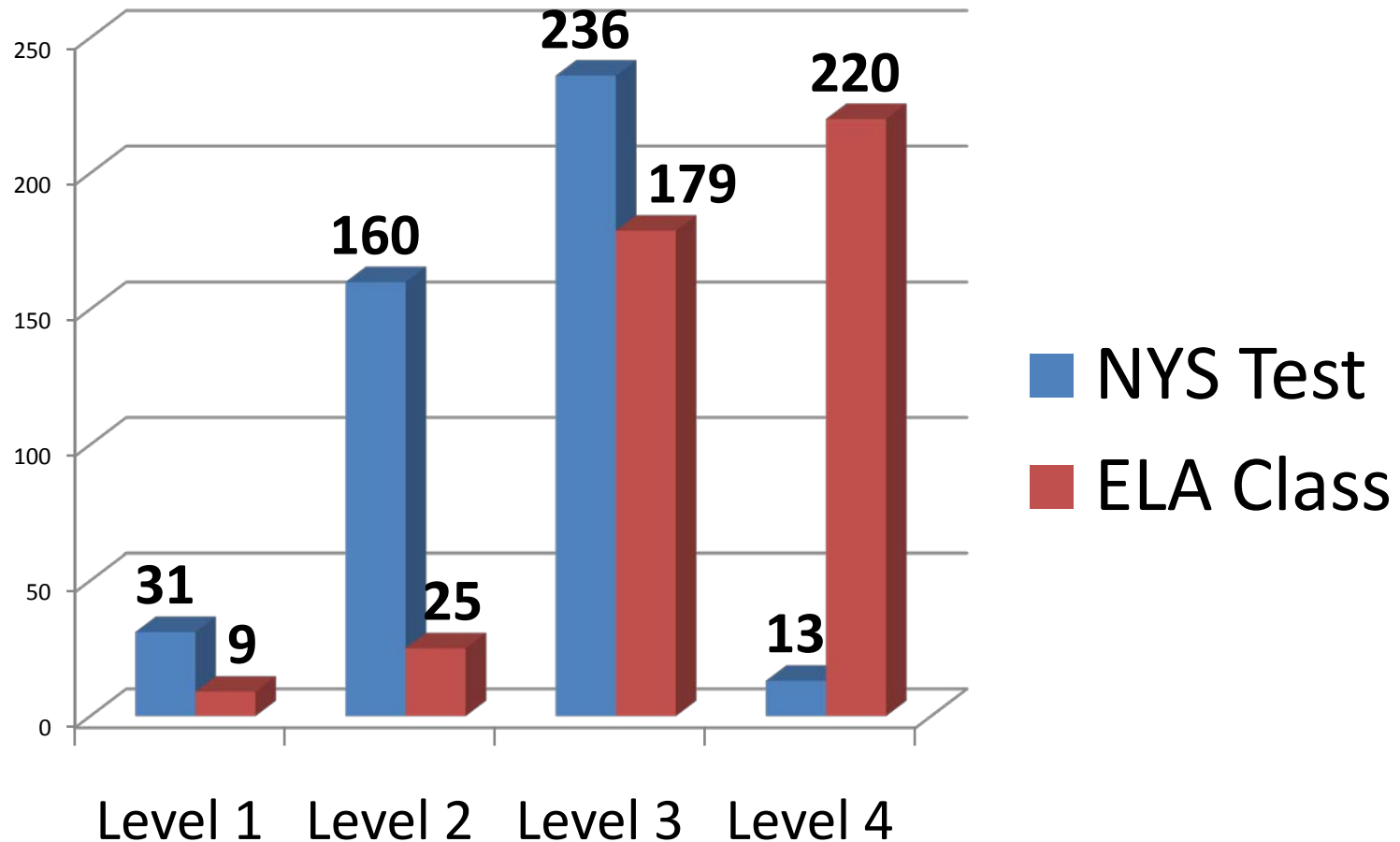

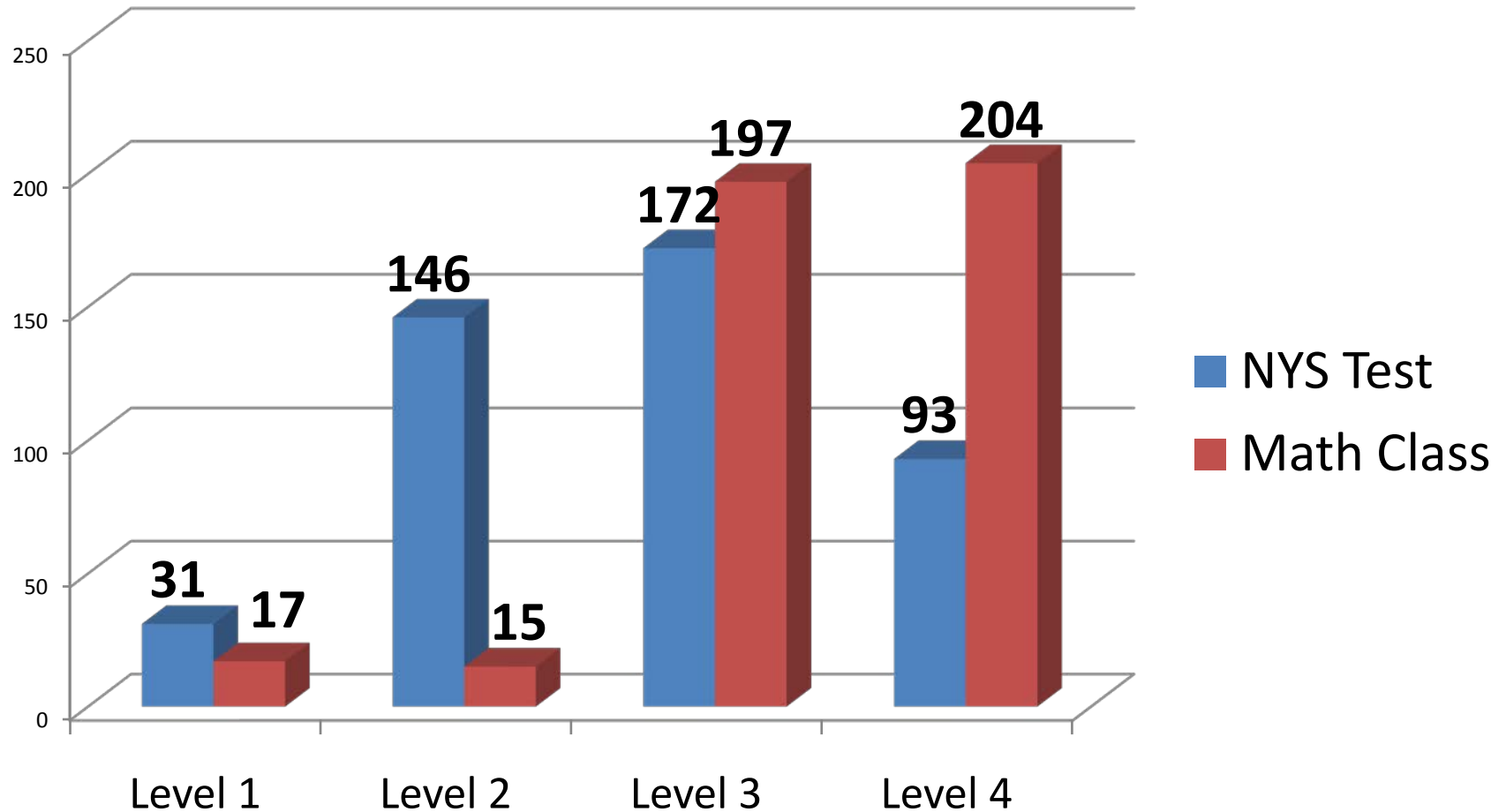

Middle School ELA Comparison (Course & State Test)

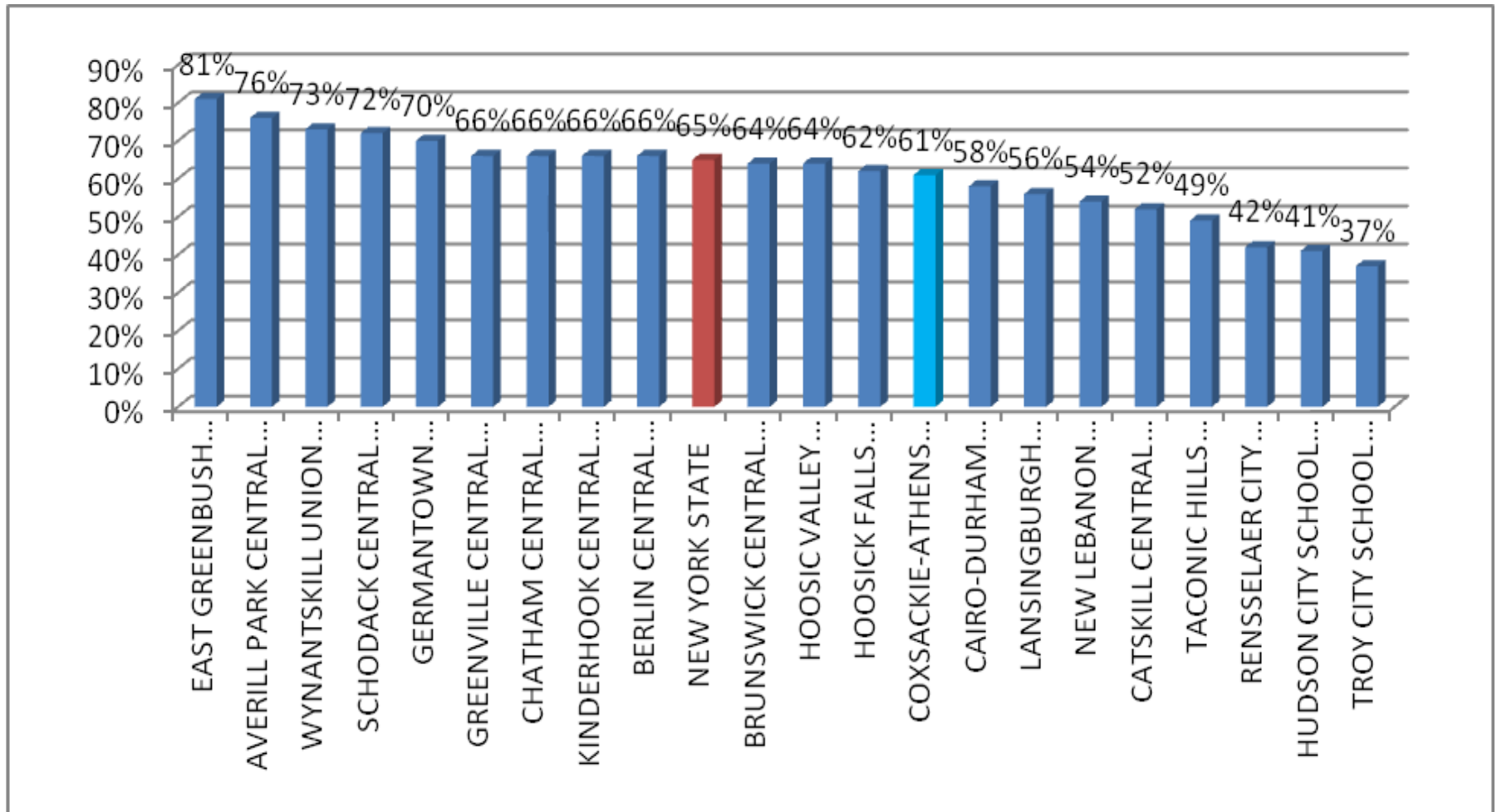


Middle School Math Comparison (Course & State Test)



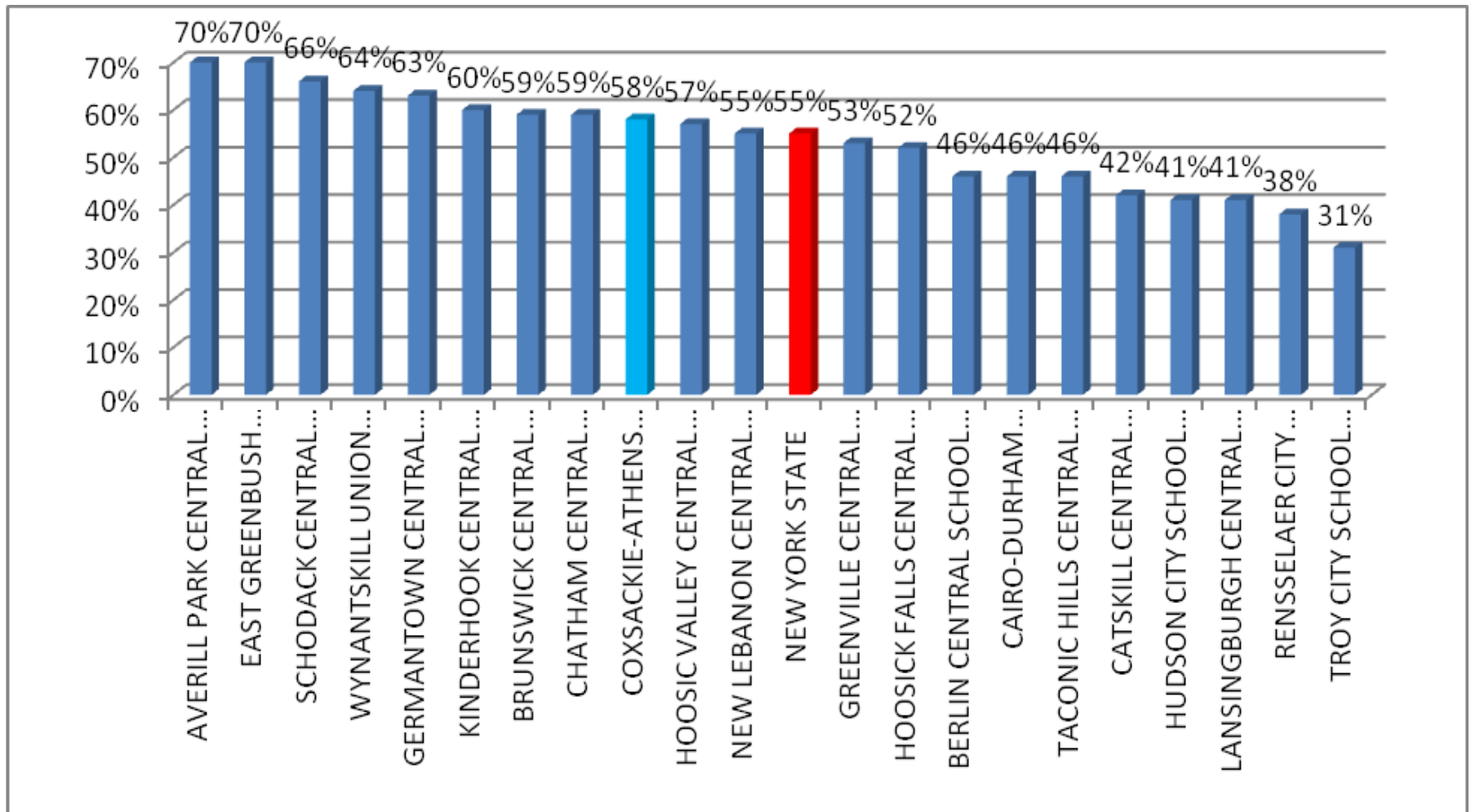
2012 Regional 3-8 Math Results

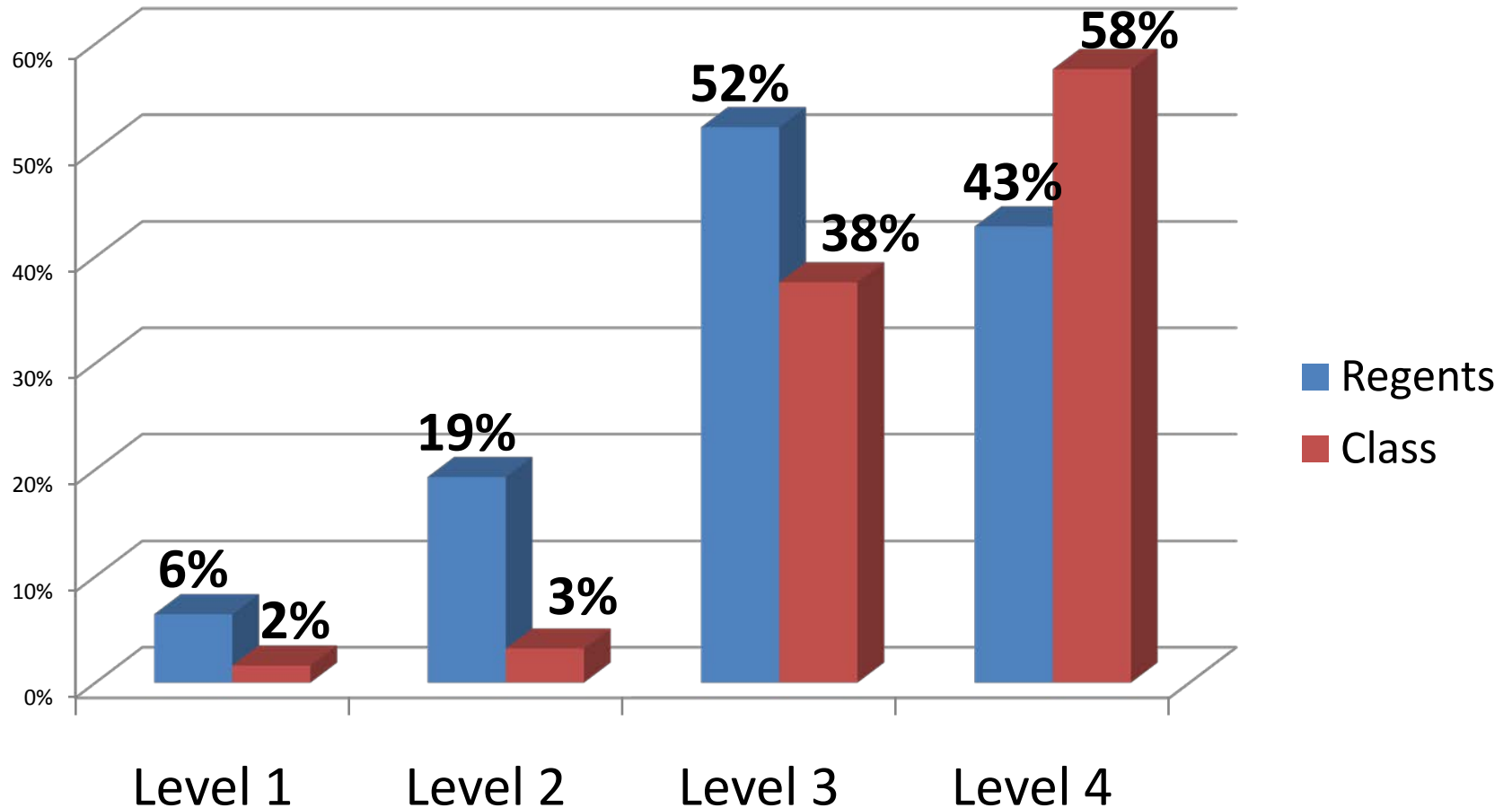

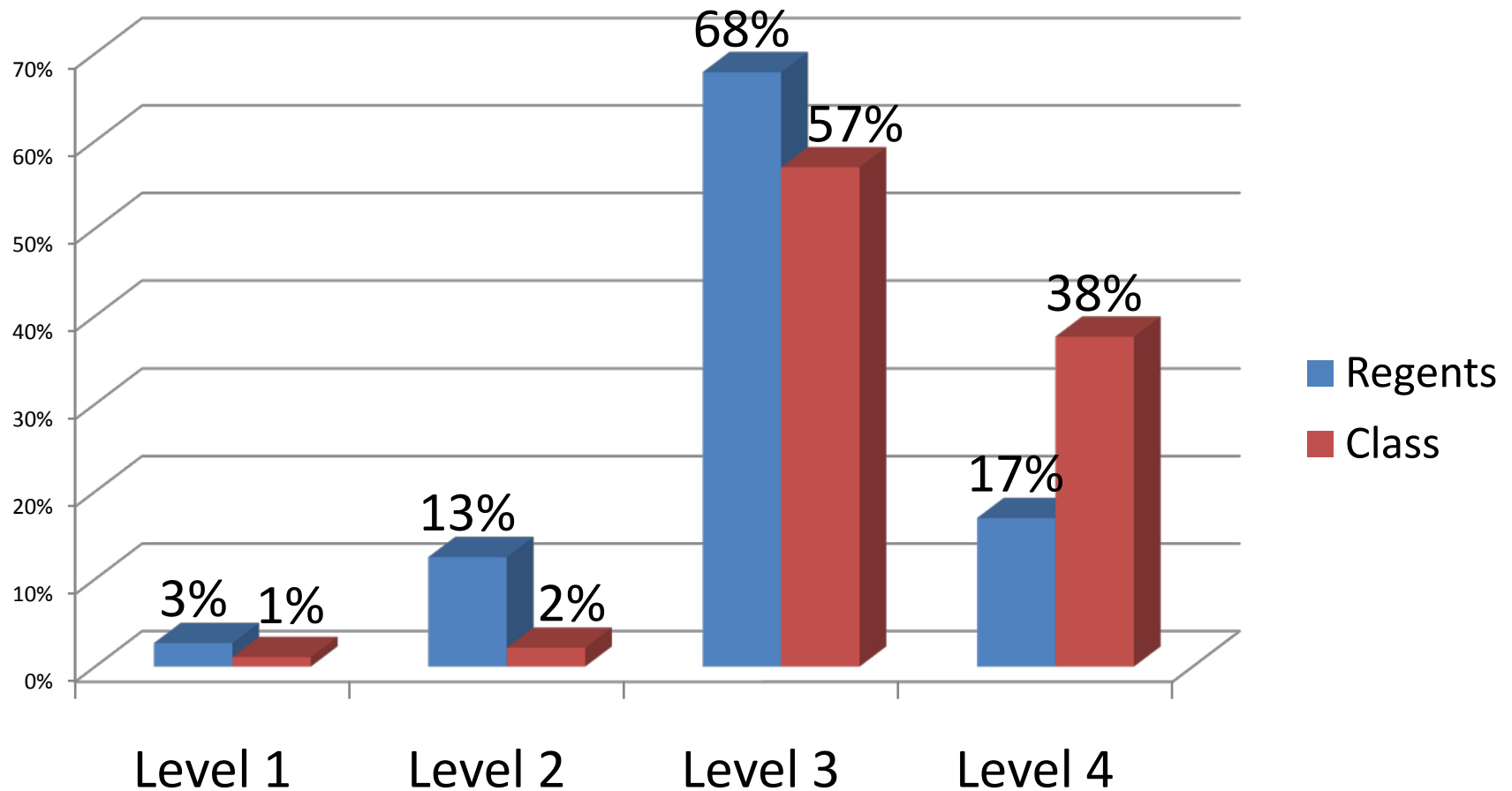

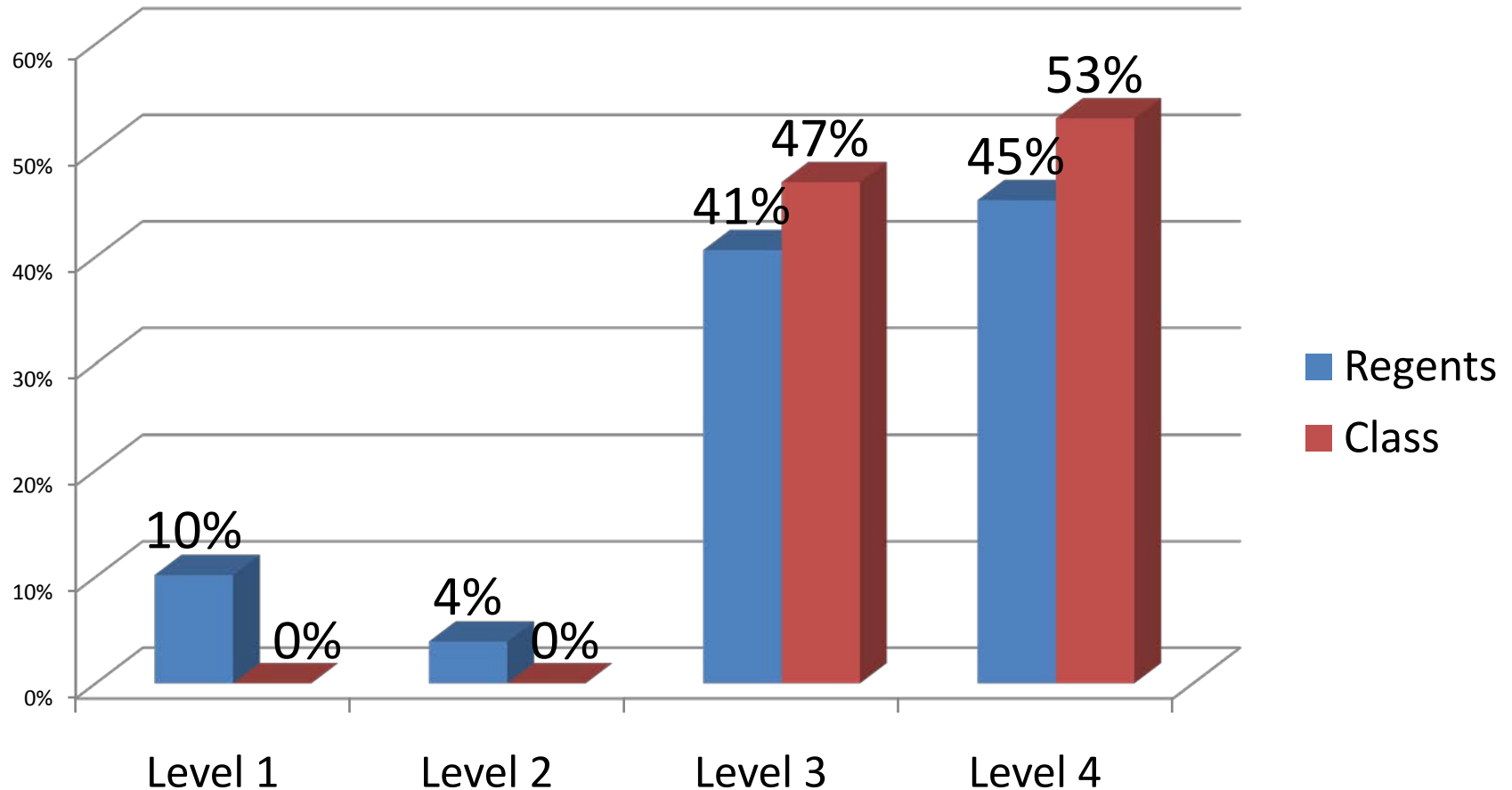
High School ELA Comparison (Course & State Test)



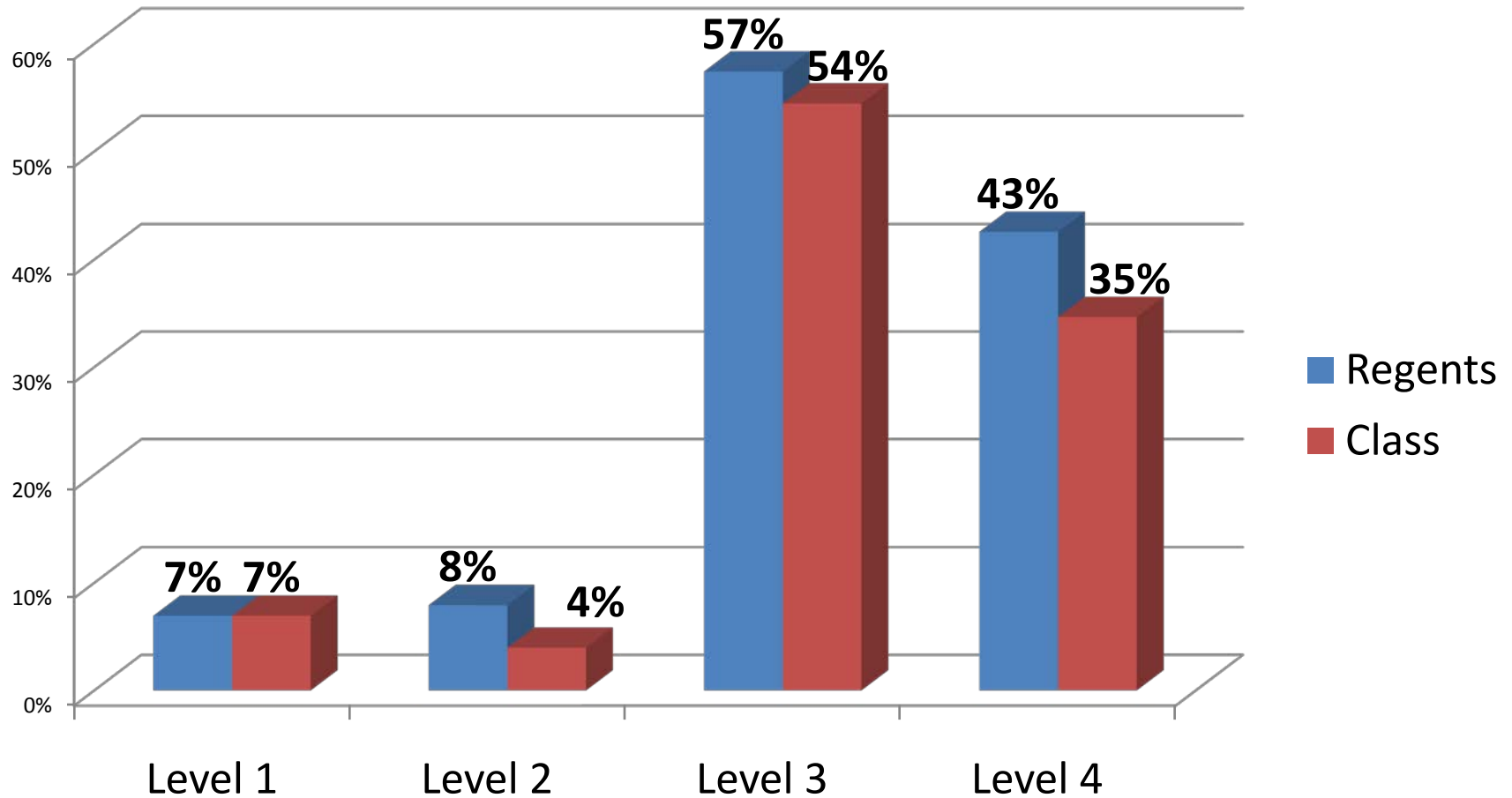
High School Algebra Comparison (Course & State Test)

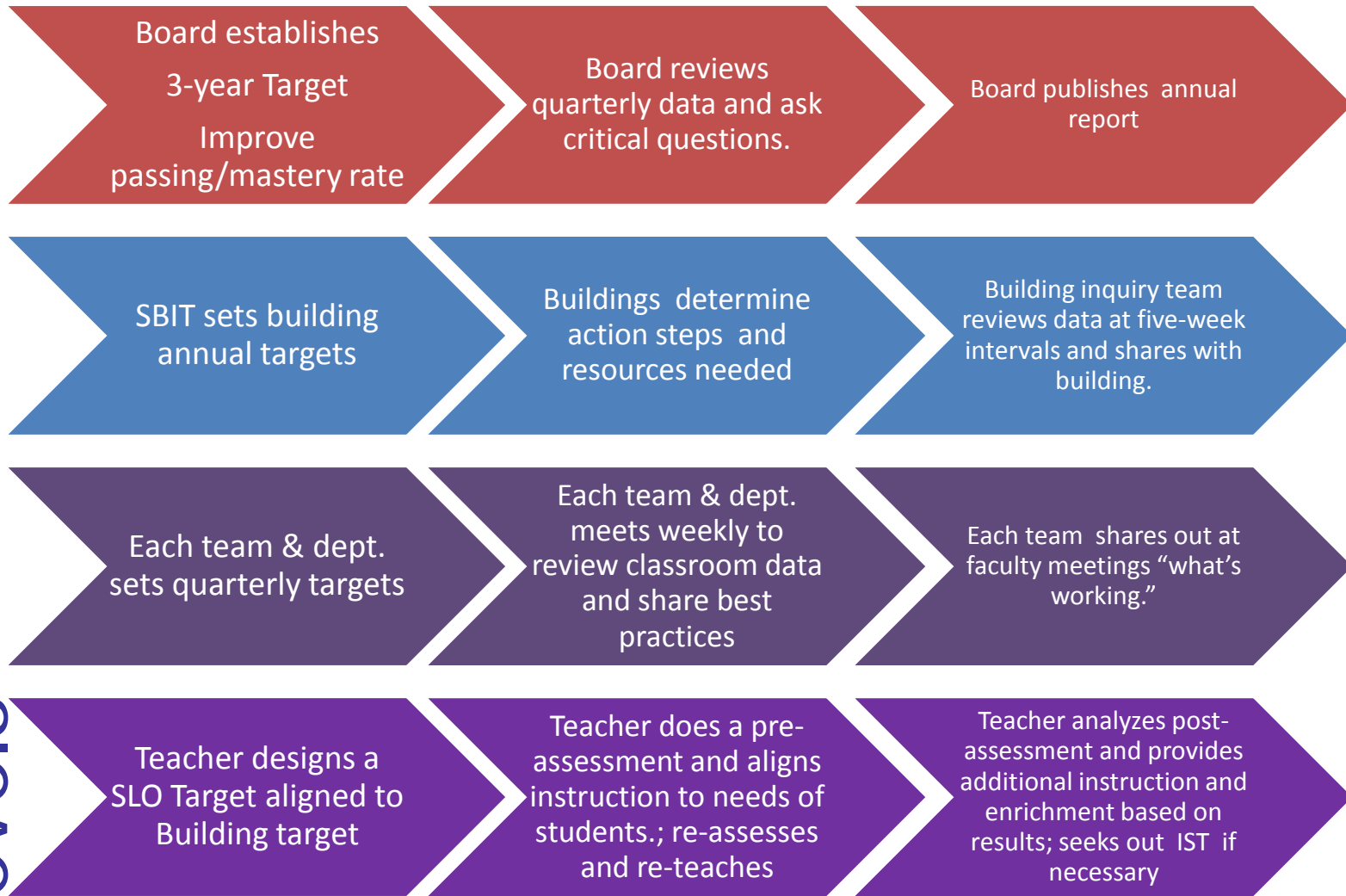

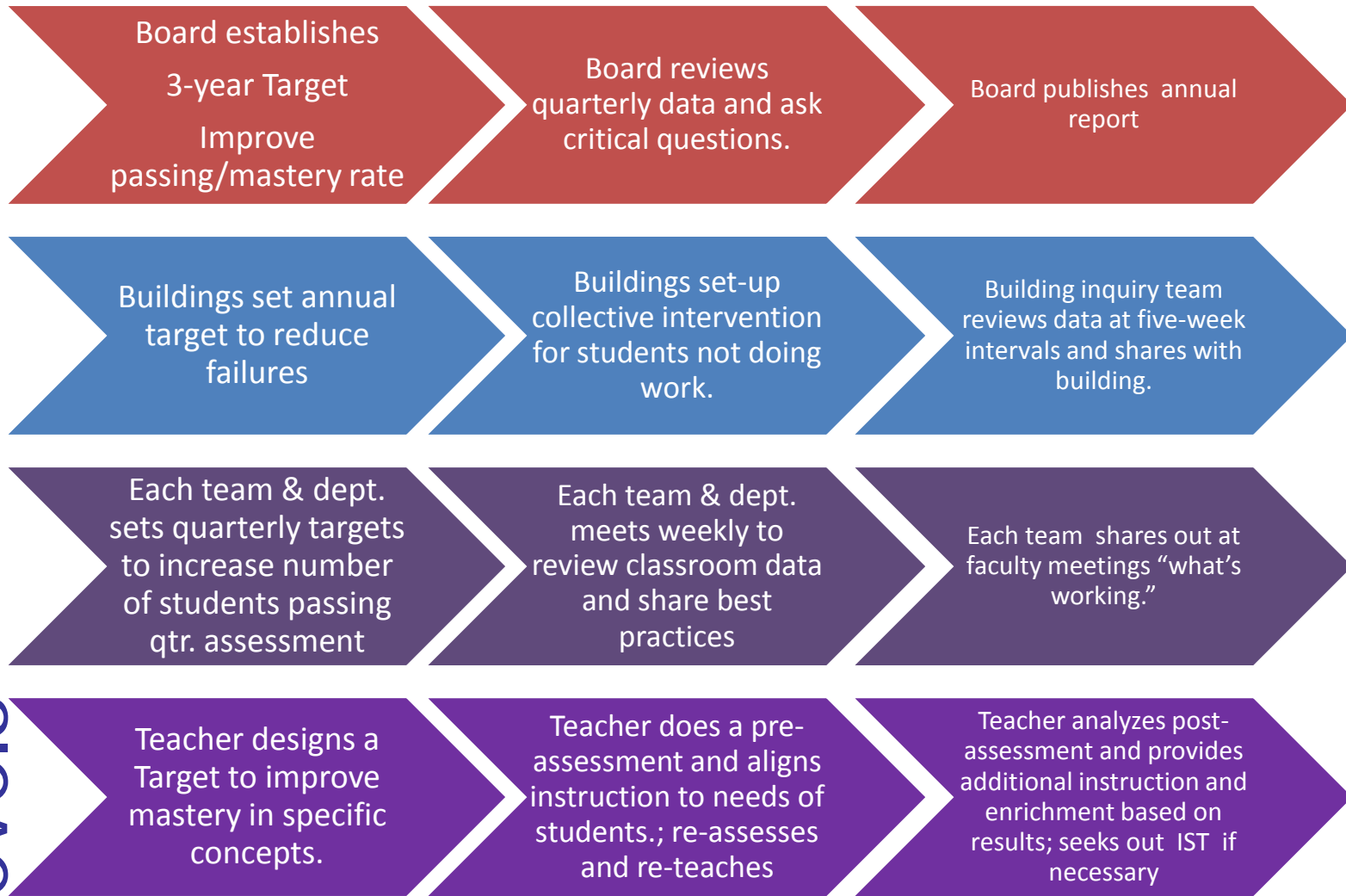
