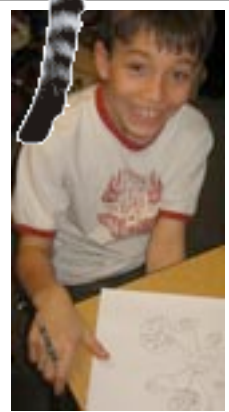
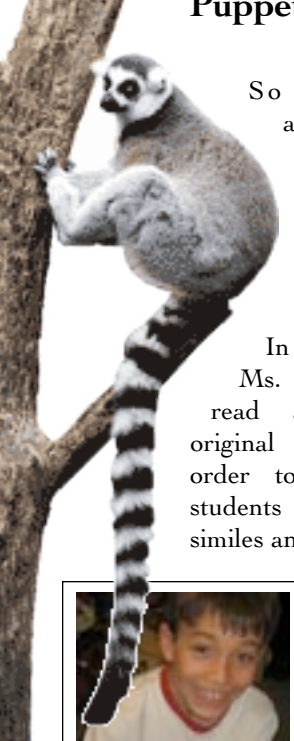
In kindergarten and first grade students created puppets out of paper mache, fabric and socks in art class which will likely appear in many impromptu puppet shows this vacation.

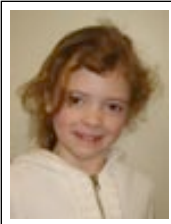
