Summer Learning Program

June 14th – July 9th

The district recognizes the impact that Covid-19 has had on education this school year and is excited to offer a summer learning program for students in grades K through 12 to combat some of this learning loss and prepare students for success next school year.

Below is a list of information that pertains to the Summer Learning Program

- The program will consist of 16 days, Monday - Thursday (except for the last week which will be Tuesday through Friday due to the Fourth of July weekend).
- K-6 grade classes will be held at Bobtown Elementary School and 7-12 grade classes will be held at Mapletown Jr/Sr High School.
- Elementary classes will consist of ELA, math and science lessons and Mapletown classes will consist of junior high and high school ELA, math, science, and history courses. Mapletown students will register for 1 or 2 courses. Each Mapletown course is ½ day.
- The school day will be 8 am – 2 pm, consisting of an 8:00 – 10:45 am morning class, a free lunch (10:45-11:15), and an afternoon 11:15 – 2:00 pm class.
- Transportation will be available for students who need it.
- Students must be enrolled SEG students during the 2020-21 school year.
- All classes will be in person, and the district will implement COVID-19 safety measures.
- Teachers will be comprised of SEG teachers, as well as other qualified teachers.
- There is no cost for participation in the summer learning program.
- These courses are being offered to (1) provide an opportunity for enhanced learning opportunities and (2) provide the opportunity for students to recover credits for classes they did not pass this school year.

In order to plan for this summer learning program, the district needs to know how many of its students plan on taking advantage of this opportunity. If a student is interested in participating, we ask that you complete the Summer Learning Program Enrollment form that will be sent to student school emails on Friday, April 23rd. Please complete and submit (electronically send) this form no later than May 1st.
