### OTHER TRIP DETAILS

While we do not have all of the detailed specifics, we wanted to make sure that we can give you the best image of what this trip will look like. Students will be rooming 4 to a room and they will be allowed to pick their roommates. Throughout the trip they will be split up into groups where they will be constantly with a chaperone. We will have hotel security all night every night to ensure that the kids are safely remaining in their rooms. The only meals that are not provided to the students are the two meals that we will be having during our traveling, every other meal will be provided for the entire trip. We are also currently working with the school nurse on how we will go about medication throughout the trip, but more details about that will come as we get closer to the trip date.

### ELIGIBILITY

#### Students:

Any current 7<sup>th</sup> grade or higher student that is a member of band throughout the entirety of the 2021-2022 school year is eligible for the trip as long as they..

- 1. Have no outstanding band fees by Concert UIL (Spring) 2022
- 2. Are eligible AND participate in Marching UIL, Concert UIL and/or all winterguard performances

Or

Any current 6<sup>th</sup> grade or higher student that is a member of the colorguard/winterguard throughout the entirety of the 2021-2022 school year is eligible for the trip as long as they..

- 1. Have no outstanding band fees by Concert UIL (Spring) 2022
- 2. Are eligible AND participate in Marching UIL and all winterguard performances

#### Chaperones:

We can have as many chaperones as would like to come on the trip, but we are limiting the amount that are eligible for the chaperone discount to only ten chaperones which will be on a first come, first serve basis.

In order to be eligible for the chaperone discount, the adult must be an active member of the band boosters for the 2021-2022 school year. For more information on how to join our band boosters, please reach out to our current band booster president, Tony Briones; jourdantonbandboosters@gmail.com

#### Other Adults:

Another other adults wishing to go on the trip but not as a chaperone are more than welcome to (dependent on seat availability). The pricing will vary as it is based on how many people to a room.

### Causes for Loss of Eligibility

Administration reserves the right to revoke field trip privileges for any student who violates the JISD Code of Conduct, the HS/JHS Band Handbook, or displays any inappropriate behaviors throughout the school year. Students who obtain ISS or Brown, or display any other form of inappropriate behavior will be reviewed by administration to determine whether or not they are eligible for the trip. Students who fail to remain eligible for all UIL/TECA contests and students who fail to attend all UIL/TECA contests will also lose their eligibility.

Eligibility for Marching UIL will occur on September 24th, 2021 - Full Refund available. Eligibility for Concert UIL will occur on February 25th, 2022 - 50% Refund available. TECA(Winterguard) contest dates have not been set yet to help determine refund eligibility.
