## Full-Time In-Person Instruction

- If/when we move into **YELLOW** status and the numbers are trending in a better direction, then a decision will be made to allow full time in-person instruction.

- When the student returns the completed packet to the nurse, the student will be given an appointment for his/her physical.
- We will try to schedule sports physicals in the fall for Edgar School Athletes.
