Corona Virus Information Update

Dear Parents

In an effort to provide consistent and accurate information related to the Coronavirus (COVID-19).

- Students at Winnacunnet High School who recently returned from Italy (one of the high risk countries) will be under a quarantine for 14days and not allowed to participate in any school activities.
- Siblings who attend school in SAU 90 Hampton Schools will be allowed to attend school. We are encouraging families to self-monitor for any symptoms including fever or cough and difficulty breathing.
- For students who traveled abroad to known level 2 or level 3 transmission areas (including China, Iran, South Korea, Italy, Japan) as part of a non-school related trip over February vacation should self exclude from school and school related activities for 14 days until March 16th, 2020. If you and your family meet these criteria please contact your school principal.
- Any students excluded from school during this time will not be penalized for absences. Schools will provide access to curricula as needed.
