Roadmap to Return to School September 1, 2020

The district is working with a broad representation of staff, parents and community to develop a plan to address the safe and healthy return of students in September.

The committees address all components of the following school aspects;

- Wellness
- Instruction
- Operations (food service, transportation, athletics, after school activities and nursing services)
- Facilities
- Technology

Once a draft plan is formulated, given the four scenarios of returning, the district will provide opportunity for parent and community input.

- Students return to school with all of the safety and wellness protocols employed
- Students continue in a remote learning environment
- Hybrid approach with face to face and remote learning
- Rolling enrollment based on status of COVID-19
