Dear Parent(s)/Guardian(s):

The U.S. Department of Education has informed States that standardized assessments will not be waived for this school year. Therefore, D48 will be administering the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR) to all students in grades 3-8. Testing will begin on Monday, May 4, and conclude on Friday, May 14. If a child is ill on a day of testing, we have makeup options and will test them when they return to school. Please do not, under any circumstances, send your child to school if they are not feeling well. Students will be testing daily for anywhere between 60-90 minutes, depending on the test being administered. All students will complete three mathematics assessments and three ELA assessments.

While IAR testing is important, please remember it is one measure of what your child currently knows in mathematics and ELA. There are a variety of skills, attributes, and dispositions we look to instill in our students in D48 that are not measured by the IAR.

Below you will find the testing sessions as well as your child's testing schedule. If you have any questions prior to testing, please contact your building administrator.
