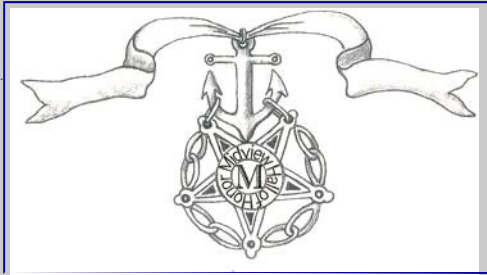


“MAKE A DIFFERENCE” HALL OF HONOR AWARD

A SYMBOL OF OUR HISTORY AND PRIDE



The Midview Medal of Honor logo was created by Mrs. Judy Otten, Midview High School art teacher. To create the logo, Mrs. Otten spent many hours researching, creating and designing medals of honor, incorporating symbolism into an emblem worthy of Midview Pride. Some interesting facts behind its symbolism are:

- The five points of the star, a trait all medals of honor share, also represent the five schools that make up the Midview District.
- The anchor at the top of the medal represents Midview’s stability and strength.
- Each point of the star is connected by two chain links, symbolizing how the individuals of the Midview community work together to keep the district strong—including Midview staff, volunteers, community members, and families.

All honorees of this award will be presented with their own Midview Medal of Honor—a symbol of their role in the history of our district’s greatness.

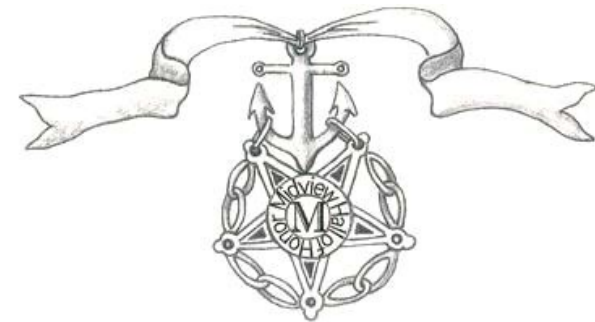

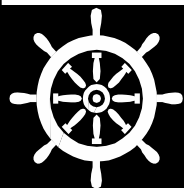

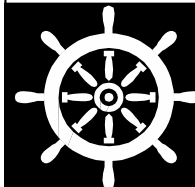
