
#### **COMMUNITY SCHOOLS SUMMER CAMP!**

# PISD SCHOOL BOARD APPROVES OVER \$270,000 IN IMPROVEMENTS

The Board of Education approved recommendations made by Superintendent Lisa Hamilton to improve and enhance outdoor learning spaces.




A shade structure will be constructed to cover the Serenity Garden Patio at the MS/HS providing a comfortable space for students.

Outdoor fitness equipment will be installed near the serenity garden. This will improve recess and PE classes. It is also an asset for the community.



A large outdoor classroom, 30 x 75, will be constructed near the Elementary School



A new playground will be constructed for the elementary early childhood grades, Preschool, PreK, and Kindergarten. It will have a tricycle path with a transportation theme.
