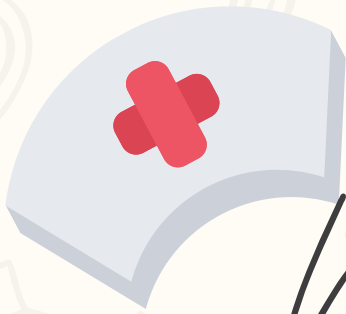

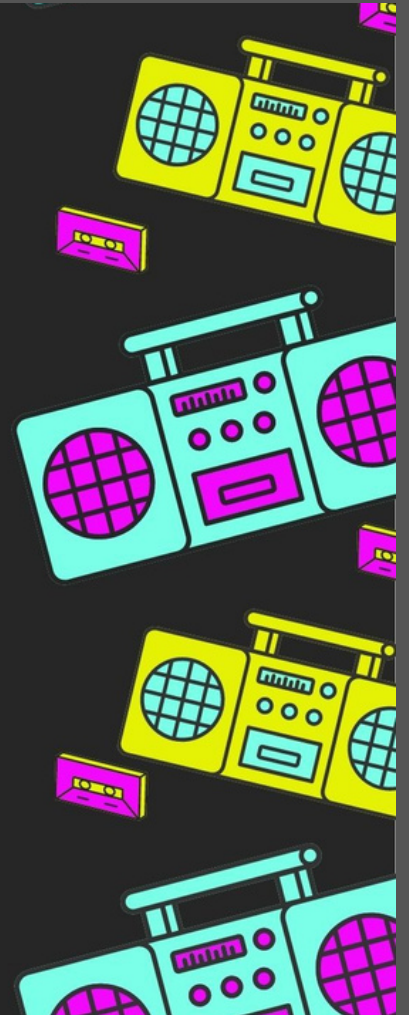

Summer School Meal Update



The USDA waivers that allowed all students to receive meals at no charge during the last two school years will expire on the last day of school. For the Richmond R-XVI School District, this will be May 19th. Summer School will mark the return of normal student meal prices.

Those already approved for free and reduced meal benefits for 2021-2022 will be automatically approved for free meals during Summer School and the first 30 school days of the start of next school year (2022-2023). All students that are eligible for Free and Reduced meals will be able to eat for free or reduced this summer. If you did not apply in the 2021-2022 and you feel you qualify, we ask that you please complete the 2021-2022 Free and Reduced Meal application and submit it as soon as possible. We need your application completed in order for your child to qualify for free meals during the 2022 summer session. This data is also used for your possible eligibility for P-EBT benefits, funding and grants for many programs. If you have not received notification by letter regarding eligibility for your students for the 2021-2022 school year, your students will transition to full pay eligibility at the start of summer school, June 6th.

If you are not eligible for Free and Reduced Meal Benefits but are planning to send your child to summer school, please make sure to add money to their account. You may send this with your student or use Rev-Trak through your parent login to your students account. This will allow them to be able to take advantage of the breakfast and/or lunches provided. Below are the 2020/2021 meal prices that we will continue to honor for summer school.

Congratulations to Tyson and Ellison for earning positive referrals! Way to set the example and be Spartan leaders by helping a substitute.



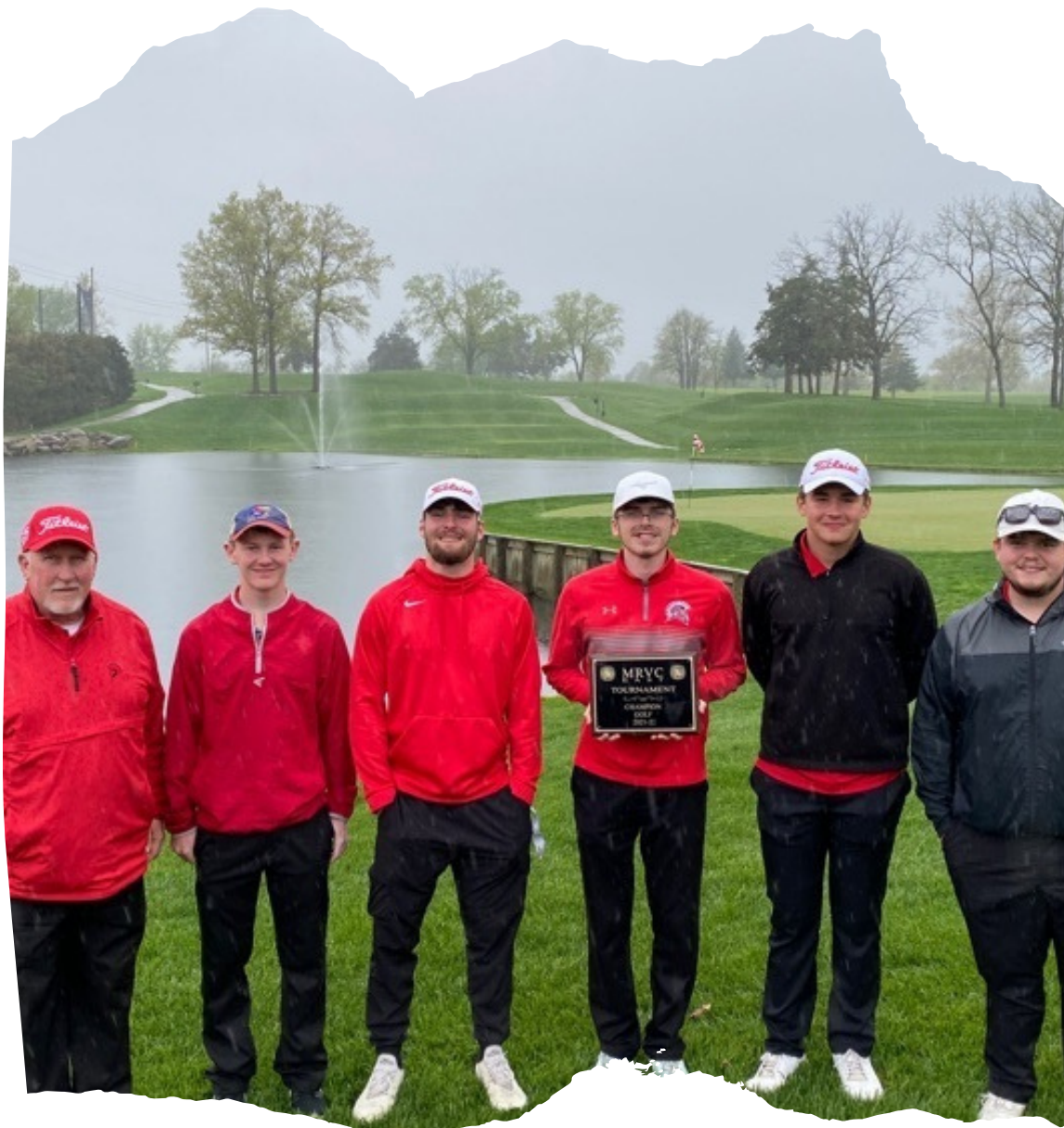
