Locate and identify children and youth ages birth through 21 with disabilities who are in need of special education and related services. Inform parents and/or guardians of the services available from their local school system and other state and community agencies.



WHAT HELP IS AVAILABLE?

A complete evaluation and, if appropriate An Individualized Education Program for children with a disability beginning at age 3.

An Individual Family Service Plan for each child with a disability birth through 2.

A referral to other agencies when needed.
