## REGIONAL SCHOOL UNIT NO. 57 2021-2022 SCHOOL BUDGET NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

TO: Jessica N. Carll, a resident of Regional School Unit No. 57 (the "RSU") composed of the Towns of Alfred, Limerick, Lyman, Newfield, Shapleigh, and Waterboro, State of Maine.

In the name of the State of Maine, you are hereby required to notify the voters of each of the municipalities within the RSU, namely, the Towns of Alfred, Limerick, Lyman, Newfield, Shapleigh, and Waterboro, that a RSU Public Hearing will be held by remote participation at 7:00 p.m. on May 5, 2021 for the purpose of public participation in and receipt of public comment on the proposed 2021-2022 school budget and on the referendum questions set forth below. Pursuant to Title 1, section 403-A of the Maine Revised Statutes, the School Board has determined that the hearing will be conducted by remote means and may be accessed by the public as follows:

The following questions will be considered at a Regional School Unit No. 57 budget referendum election to be held on June 8, 2021.

Article 1: School Budget. Shall Regional School Unit No. 57 appropriate the sum of \$44,943,662 and raise the sum of \$28,364,300 for the 2021-2022 school budget? (The Board of Directors recommends a Yes vote.)

## **VOTER INFORMATION FOR ARTICLE 1**

The Regional School Unit No. 57 school budget submitted in this Article 1 totals \$44,943,662. It includes locally raised funds in the amount of \$28,364,300, to be assessed in shares to member municipalities in accordance with the RSU's cost sharing formula and state law. The locally raised amount exceeds the State's Essential Programs and Services funding model by \$7,133,719. This budget includes these cost centers and amounts:

Article 2: RSU Adult Ed Program. Shall the Regional School Unit be authorized to appropriate \$340,423 for the Massabesic Center for Adult Learning and raise \$160,564 as the local share for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2021 and ending June 30, 2022, with authorization to expend any additional, incidental, or miscellaneous receipts in the interest and for the well-being of the adult education program.
