The Tolono Public Library District and Unit 7 Schools are working together to provide library service to all children that qualify for the free and reduced lunch program. This program, known statewide as Cards For Kids, provides access to Illinois' public libraries to students who meet specific income guidelines, regardless of where they currently reside in Illinois. The children in your household meet these guidelines and can access the program.

The Tolono Public Library District offers many resources, including:

- Books, DVDs, audiobooks, and more;
- Electronic Database resources
- Summer Reading and other programming activities;

If you would like to assist your child with obtaining a library card at the Tolono Public Library, you will need to bring the following to the Tolono Public Library, located at 111 E. Main Street, Tolono, IL;

- **Driver's license of the guardian that will sign for the child's card**
- **A piece of mail indicating your address (or you can provide your driver's license if it is updated)**
- **This letter indicating that your child qualifies for the Cards For Kids program**

The library card that is issued is intended only for the child whose name is on the card rather than the whole household.
