

In order for software to interpret and average letter marks we must assign them a point value in ParentAccess only. When looking at your student's grades in ParentAccess you will see an overall Effort or Standards grade depending on what screen you look at as explained in this document. Next to that overall Effort or Standards grade you will see a percentage. PLEASE IGNORE THIS **PERCENTAGE!** This is how the software averages out the marks and unfortunately we cannot hide this percentage without also hiding the Effort or Standards marks. 

Notice on this Assignments screen there are four assignments but they are listed twice. The top section is the assignment Effort grade if given by the teacher. The bottom section, if given by the teacher, is the standard that the assignment was graded on. Remember for GradeBook to understand the standard marks of E, M, P, L we have to assign the marks a number. **E=4, M=3, P=2, L=1**. This is why in the bottom section you will see 3/4, 2/4, etc...
