



Information to share with the parents of your students who will be affected beginning Monday 3 May 2021:

Chattahoochee County Schools were notified yesterday afternoon by the Cusseta-Chattahoochee County Government of GADOT work that will shut down Manta Road from Firetower Road to Ga Hwy 520/280 indefinitely beginning Monday 3 May 2021.

This road closure unfortunately, will affect the transportation of all students who live on this section of Manta Road and the those on south side of Gordy Mill Pond Road past the existing dam. Chattahoochee County Schools will not be able to run buses in those areas until GADOT officially reopens Manta Road from Ga Hwy 520/280. These changes impact the following buses for the Manta Road and south side of Gordy Mill Pond Road.

CCMHS - Blue Bus
CCEC - Brown Bus

Based on what we have been made aware of, beginning Monday 3 May, parents will need to choose one of the following transportation options for getting their students to school:

1. Parents may choose to use an existing Red Bus Stop which is located on the Red Oak side of Gordy Mill Pond Road at the intersection of Gordy Mill Pond Road and Sabbath Lane by either:

A. Transporting their student(s) to and from this location to ride Red Bus 04-2.

Or

B. Allowing their students to walk to and from this location to ride Red Bus 04-2

Red Bus approximate arrival times at Gordy Mill Pond Rd & Sabbath Lane are as follows:

CCMHS	6:45 AM	3:10 PM
CCEC	7:50 AM	3:50 PM
