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## QUALIFICATIONS FOR VOTERS

According to Education Law, to be qualified to vote in a school district election, a person must be:

1. At least 18 years of age
2. A legal resident of the school district for 30 days to the date of the vote\*
3. A citizen of the United States
4. Not otherwise prohibited from voting pursuant to Election Law § 5-106.

\*A person may have only one legal residence which is normally determined by a combination of the following:

1. The place that he or she votes in a federal, state, or local election.
2. The place where he or she pays income taxes.
3. The place where his or her automobile is registered.

## PROCEDURES FOR MILITARY BALLOTS

Military voters who are qualified voters of the District may apply for a military ballot by requesting an application from the District Clerk. For a military voter to be issued a military ballot, the District Clerk must have received a valid ballot application no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 22, 2021. In a request for a military ballot application or ballot, the military voter may indicate a preference for receiving the application or ballot by mail, facsimile, or electronic mail.

Any military voter who is a District resident qualified to vote at this election and needs to use a Military Ballot should contact the District Clerk's office, 203 East Main Street, Westfield, NY 14787 (716-326-2151) to request an application. In making such request, the military voter may indicate a preference for receiving the application by mail, facsimile, or electronic mail.

### Application for Military Ballot

Completed applications must be returned by mail or in-person. Application must be received by the District Clerk no later than 5:00 p.m. on April 22, 2021.
