Dear Boothbay- Boothbay Harbor CSD Families,

On Monday, May 3rd, The Boothbay Harbor Sewer District is beginning a project on the sewer lines at the entrance to the school campus. The project will be beginning between 7:45 - 8:00 AM and work will take place throughout the day. Townsend Avenue in front of the school will be one way traffic. There will be workers directing traffic for the duration of the project and the entrance to the school will become two way traffic.

The Sewer District is going to do what they can to minimize the impact to the school, but there will most likely be congestion on Townsend Ave and on the school property when trying to leave.

There will most likely be delays so please plan accordingly. If the project is not completed by school dismissal there could be significant delays exiting and entering the campus. This work should only impact The CDS campus on Monday 5/3/21. The project will be continuing down Townsend the following day(s). You should expect traffic slow-downs on Townsend Avenue until the project is complete.
