While looking over the consent agenda, a discussion about free meals for all students until December 31<sup>st</sup>.

- A motion was made at 6:31 pm Darick Brown and seconded by Andy McCandlis to approve the continuation of the Seamless Summer Option as long as this will allow all of Viola's students to eat free through the cafeteria.. The motion was approved 5/0.
- A motion was made at 6:32 pm Ken Cotter and seconded by Darick Brown to approve the Consent Agenda. (minutes and expenditures from August, Minority Teacher and Administrator Recruitment Plan, and Act 1120 5% Salary Increases) The motion was approved 5/0.
- A motion was made at 6:35 pm Andy McCandlis and seconded by Charlie Wray to approve the Policy Agenda (Delayed Start Calendar and COVID Emergency Leave Policies). The motion was approved 5/0.
- A motion was made at 6:39 pm Ken Cotter and seconded by Andy McCandlis to approve a correction to the Class Rank section of the handbook. The motion was approved 5/0.
- A motion was made at 6:49 pm Darick Brown and seconded by Charlie Wray to reassign Destiny Brueckner as a fulltime self-contained special ed teacher effective Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> for 138 days. (Destiny will still receive pay for days worked prior to Sept 22<sup>nd</sup> at the rate of a special ed handicapped aide.) The motion was approved 5/0.

The board then discussed several issues related to basketball games including restricting seating, livestreaming, concession stand, rescheduling and/or relocating some games. The board also discuss some of their options for annual training before adjourning.
