Head Coach: Kyle Green



Coach Kyle Green will be entering his 16th year as head coach of the Wildcats in 2021-2022. Under Coach Green the Wildcats have won 2 SCBL Titles (2 of the total 4 SCBL titles in program history) 1 SCBL Tourney Title (1 of 2 in program history), and he has taken 3 teams to the sub-state finals in his tenure. With OHS's 62-28 win over Central Burden on Jan 29th of 2016, Coach Green passed Oxford legend Coach Cliff Barnhart (1945-1953) as the all-time winningest coach in OHS boys' basketball history. Coach Green collected his 200th career win on 2/19/20 vs. Flinthills. Coach Green believes in his FAMILY Culture within the program and his main goal is to develop great young men! Coach Green works with the Wildcat Guards.

The Oxford Basketball Camp is returning for its 16th year in Oxford, Kansas this summer. Camp options are below. (Grades reflect the grade your student will be in next school year!) The cost for each session of camp is \$20.00

Future Cats Camp: This portion of camp is designed to teach our younger kids the fundamentals of the game. We will cover the basics: dribbling, ball handling, shooting, footwork, defense, as well as rules of the game in a fun environment. Boys and Girls 1st-5th grade are eligible to attend this portion of camp. It will be held in the Old Gym at OHS.

The Program Camp: This camp is for boys in grades 6-12. The boys that attend this camp will learn the system that has been developed here in the OHS Boys Program. This portion of camp was created to foster a greater sense of **FAMILY** within the Jr. High and High School Programs. I must emphasize that the Jr. High boys **WILL NOT** be playing against the high school boys. They will be learning from the high school boys and the camp staff in an environment that will be designed to create a greater sense of family and being as one total basketball program. The goal is to create players who want to be a part of the Wildcat Family. **Kids who attend this portion of camp must have basketball court only shoes due to our new gym floor! No outside shoes are allowed.**
