Please note requirements-

If living with a Metuchen Resident Home Owner-

Home owner must complete and Notarize **Affidavit A**

- Owner presents current Tax Bill, Driver's License and Current Utility Bill
- Guardian of student must bring;
– Insurance or Bank statement and Driver's License with Metuchen Address.

If living with a person leasing in Metuchen-

Renter must present **Affidavit B** to the Landlord/Property Owner to be completed and Notarized.

- The lease must be current and present for registration along with Current Utility bill.
(month to month leases will not be accepted)
- Guardian of student must bring;
– Insurance or Bank statement and Driver's License with Metuchen Address.
