Eventually the Box Tops program will become digital-only. Participating brands are starting to change their packaging from a traditional Box Tops clip to the new Box Tops label.

Use the new Box Tops app to scan your receipt. **Box Tops are still worth 10¢ for your school.** The app will find participating products purchased at any store and instantly add cash to your school's earnings online.

Thank you to parents and students for collecting box-tops for us this year AND using the new digital APP. **We've earned some additional money** to help replace and buy new books for the library. **PLEASE** turn in **ANY** box tops you have by May 27th. Many of the 2021 box tops expire on June 1 and we'd like to get them counted and sent in for our count.

Library Statistics!

As of 04/28/21 students and teachers at EES have checked out 19,852 books from the library.

In this school year so far:

**9,147 AR tests have been taken with an 83% average correct.

**37,624,163 words have been read.
