- 1. The meeting of the Building Committee was called to order by Chair Medved at 6:00 p.m. Building Committee Members Present: Brian Medved, Michael Loth, Mark Koenke, Ray Borden, Board of Education Members Sarah Larson, Tom Barney, Amanda Reinemann, District Administration and Staff, Brett Stousland, Brittany Altendorf, Don Erickson,
- 2. Motion by Loth to approve the agenda as presented. Second by Borden. Motion carried.
- 3. Motion by Koenke to approve the Julu 13, 2020, Building Committee minutes as presented. Second by Borden. Motion carried.
- 4. Erickson led discussions on Capital Projects and Facility Services by describing the items included in the Committee packet. Erickson updated the Committee on his meeting with the Village of Richfield regarding the District's plans for the temporary parking lot at Amy Belle. The Committee discussed a water drainage retention plan and lighting plan that may be required for this project. Erickson will bring information and formal quotes back to the Committee at the September meeting for review. Koenke asked who would oversee the project. Medved led brief discussion on the Amy Belle infiltration basin. Erickson updated the Committee on the landscaping plans at Amy Belle. Erickson briefly discussed the pool tiling work at Germantown High School. Erickson updated the Committee on information regarding MERV (Minimum Efficiency Reporting Value) 10 and MERV 13 filters as included in the Committee packet, along with costing to upgrade our systems to accommodate MERV 13 filters. Medved and Altendorf briefly discussed federal monies and if they were available, or possible grants. Erickson discussed tuckpointing work that would be taking place at County Line School and the planned tuckpointing work that will continue and be scheduled through the 2022-2023 school year at County Line School. Loth asked if we would be replacing bricks when the tuckpointing work is being done. Medved asked Erickson for his opinon on the percentage of the District that is currently air conditioned, how we are handling humidity and what his thoughts were on an approximate cost to air condition the remainder of the District. Erickson discussed LED lighting at Germantown High School for first floor hallways in the academic wing.
- 5. Medved and Erickson led discussions on the Capital Projects/Fund 41 prioritized list provided in the packet.
- 6. Motion by Loth to adjourn the meeting. Second by Koenke. Motion carried.
- 7. Meeting adjourned at 6:18 p.m.
