MINUTES OF THE BOARD OF EDUCATION  
TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEE MEETING**

**October 31, 2019**

1. The meeting of the Transportation Committee was called to order by Committee Chair Tom Barney at 5:02 p.m. in the District Offices Board Room. Members Present: Tom Barney, Ray Borden, and Michael Loth as well as Ad-hoc committee member and Board President Bob Soderberg. Superintendent of Schools Jeff Holmes, Riteway representatives Colleen McKay and Patty Raschig, and technology support Justin Baumgartner, were also present.
2. Motion by Loth, second by Borden to approve the agenda with the elimination of IV.A. Approval of August 19, 2019 minutes. Motion carried.
3. The committee discussed a parent complaint about the amount of time their high school student was on the bus coming home and the misinformation they received that a route had been eliminated causing the delay. It was confirmed no high school routes have been eliminated and reasons for varying bus route timing were discussed. Maximum bus route lengths will not be added to policy.
4. The committee discussed elementary attendance boundaries at length and reviewed several options for alternate boundaries presented by Justin Baumgartner.
5. Motion by Loth, second by Borden to forward to the Board with a positive recommendation, approval of the first draft of the elementary attendance boundaries redraw with Area 1 moving to County Line, Area 2 moving to Rockfield, and Area 3 moving to MacArthur, and allow current fourth grade students to elect to be grandfathered into their current schools. Motion carried.
6. Motion by Loth, second by Borden to adjourn. Motion carried.
7. Committee Chair Tom Barney declared the meeting adjourned at 6:39 p.m.
