Dear North Little Rock School District Parents and Caregivers,

In an effort to address learning loss as a result of COVID-19, the North Little Rock School District is launching its Summer Learning Loss Program next month. Registration for these programs will close on **Friday, May 14, 2021**. The district's summer learning loss program will be an excellent opportunity for students to recover lost learning, reinforce skills, or engage in new learning and enrichment in order to better prepare them for the 2021-2022 school year.

The summer learning loss program is provided at no cost to families and will take place at each school site. Transportation, breakfast, and lunch will also be provided to students each day. See table below for a complete list of site locations, dates, and times.

6. North Little Rock Academy-High School	Monday June 7, 2021 to Thursday July 8, 2021 from 8:45-1:45 pm, Monday through Thursday.
Note: No classes will be held on Monday July 5, 2021 , as the district will observe the Fourth of July Holiday as all schools and central office sites will be closed.	


Students who receive a letter from their school are **required** to attend. If your student does not receive a letter, and you would like for them to attend the summer learning loss program, please call your student's school for registration information.
