The Department of Public Instruction released the first 2019/2020 Prepopulated Revenue Limit Worksheet.

On a very preliminary basis I have estimated a decrease in state imposed revenue of about <\$104,622>. There are many variables that will be determined over the next 6 months that will cause this figure to change, not the least of which is next September's 3<sup>rd</sup> Friday enrollment count.

For purposes of this estimate, I froze the enrollment from Sept 2018 to Sept 2019 thereby using a figure of 3,870 pupils. Increasing that figure by 10 pupils, results in \$30,000 less revenue. This is due to the formula variable that impacts declining enrollment exemption.

Conversely decreasing the number of students increases the limit.
