



SNOWFLAKE HIGH SCHOOL ACTIVITIES PACKET



You must bring the following information back in its entirety before a “White Card” will be issued. The following items must be on file in the Activities Office before an athlete can try out for a sport:

- 1) **Emergency Medical Treatment Form:** fill out entirely and it will be signed by both the student athlete and a parent/guardian. Insurance Information is required. Student insurance can be purchased or an insurance waiver needs to be filled out and on file (both the insurance brochures and insurance waivers are available in the HS office).
- 2) **AIA 2020-2021 Annual Pre-Participation Physical EVALUATION Forms (Page 1, 2, and 3 of the SHS Physical Packet):** This is general health questions that need to be answered each year prior to your physical by a licensed medical professional (MD/DO/ND/NMD/NP/PA-C/CCSP). Make sure it is completed and signed by a Parent/Guardian.
- 3) **AIA Annual Pre-Participation Physical EXAMINATION Form Page 4 of the SHS Physical Packet MUST be signed and dated by a licensed physician):** Students are required to have an annual physical. *Because of COVID-19, if you had a 2019-2020 AIA Physical Examination on file with the Snowflake HS Athletic Dept., you do NOT need a new physical for the 2020-2021 school year. You will need to sign the SHS Physical Examination Waiver.* But, if you are an incoming Freshman, Transfer student to SHS or did not participate in athletics last year you will be required to get a Physical Examination for the 2020-2021 school year dated **after March 1, 2020.** You can either pick up a Packet in the HS Office or fill them out online and print them off from aiaonline.org webpage (once on the webpage on the top bar “About AIA” there is a drop down you will go to “Forms – Constitution & Bylaws”. Complete and Print off Forms 15.7 (A-D).
- 4) **AIA Annual Pre-Participation ACKNOWLEDGEMENT Form (Mild Traumatic Brain Injury (MTBI) / Concussion Statement & Acknowledgement (Page 5 of the SHS Physical Packet):** Complete and both student athlete and parent/guardian will sign the form.
- 5) **AIA Consent to Treat Form (page 6 of the SHS Physical Packet):** This form allows for any Healthcare professional to treat your son/daughters injury whether it is in Snowflake or on the road as a visitor at another school.
- 6) **Snowflake High School Activities Code of Conduct and AIA Position Statement:** Both the student athlete and parent/guardian will sign the form.
- 7) **AIA Online Concussion Education Course:** Go to www.aiaacademy.org – click on the “Register for an Account”. Complete all the open fields and click “Register”. It will open the Brainbook Concussion Education course, after completion print a copy of the certificate and return with the packet. (You only have to take the course one time during your high school career)
- 8) **Birth Certificate:** You must provide a copy for the Athletic Office. A copy of the athlete’s birth certificate needs to be on file with the Athletic Office. (One copy is sufficient for the student’s high school career).

INCOMING FRESHMAN & TRANSFER STUDENT INFO



Parents and Student Athletes,

We at Snowflake High School want to welcome you to our school and community. Before a student athlete can participate in any Snowflake High School athletics, he/she must be cleared in two areas.

First, he/she must take the *mandatory concussion education course* organized and put together by the AIA (Arizona Interscholastic Association). You only need to complete this course one time, so all incoming Freshman must complete this course before they can participation in a game/event. If you are a transfer student new to Snowflake High School but have completed this course at a previous high school in Arizona, please mark down below that you have completed the course and what school you completed the course at. We will get in contact with that school's athletic director to get you cleared. If you are a transfer student from out of state, you will need to complete the course online.

This program has been organized to help inform parents, players, and school staffs information about how to avoid and recognize concussions. Follow the steps below to register and take the course:

1. Go to www.aiaacademy.org
2. Click on "Get Started" – fill out the registration information and click register.
3. Log in and take the Brainwork Concussion Course.
4. After completing the course, please print off a certificate of completion for your records.

Second, if you are a new student to Snowflake High School and are transferring from another high school the Arizona Interscholastic Association bylaw states, "Students changing enrollment to/from one high school to another school shall be considered a transferring student." (AIA Bylaw 15.10). Transferring students need to apply for athletic eligibility by going online and completing the *AIA Form 520 Application for Eligibility*.

Here are the directions that you need to complete to get eligibility to participate:

1. Go to www.aiaonline.org
2. Scroll down on the home page until you see "Quick Links" and double click on the box that says, "Student Transfer – Form 550"
3. Under student information double click on the "Begin" box
4. Complete the information given and click on the "Send" box

Just because you fill out the correct paperwork, the AIA still has the right to declare whether you are eligible or not eligible to participate.
