Welcome to APUSH for 2021-2022!!!!

To get a handle on things early and to facilitate a running start to the school year, you will be required to complete several assignments over the summer to help you prepare for the class. The first four chapters are due July 16th and the last two and your essay are DUE ON THE FIRST DAY OF CLASS.

A. American Pageant (16th AP Edition) - Chapters 1-6

- This is a college-level textbook, written in a college-level narrative with college-level vocabulary.
- As such, **it is NOT the kind of text that you can skim** ... if you do so, you will undoubtedly miss key context and concepts
- It is a text that is begging to be decorated with underlining and annotations (if you are concerned about writing in the book, invest heavily in post-it notes to be affixed next to key passages)
- You will have a guiz on this material (Ch. 1-6) the first day of school

B. Reading Questions for chapters 1-6

For each chapter throughout the year, you will be given a set of detailed reading questions and you will use *Pageant* to locate information on these key concepts, individuals and events from U.S. History. This is not intended to be busy work ... it is intended to:

- i. Help direct your attention to key questions/concepts throughout the dense text
- ii. Help you develop study guides to be used for quiz, test and AP exam prep

Reading questions can be used on *some* quizzes and they must be <u>handwritten</u>*

Ch. 1-4 Reading Questions are due by Friday, July 16

A box will be placed in the Front Office at RB for you to submit the Reading Questions.

C. Essay

• Historical analysis is an integral part of APUSH and answering the question below will provide you with a valuable opportunity to practice your writing and thinking about the colonial period.

Explain how contact between Europeans and Native Americans and their differing economic, political, and social structures, created a new world in North America through French, Spanish, and English (Jamestown) colonization. Address the conflict over natural resources in the period of the 1600's.

- Your essay should use **specific evidence** from *Pageant* (please use **in-text citations**, indicating what page you acquired your information from, ie, (23)) as well as any outside sources you use (not Wikipedia) with author's name for in-text citation (i.e.(Zinn)) and include MLA citation at the end of your essay.
- The key to this essay (and every other essay you'll write for APUSH) is that you craft a thesis that <u>clearly</u> and specifically answers the question and establishes a roadmap for the scope of your essay.

Essay should be:

• TYPED • SPELL-CHECKED • 1.5 or DOUBLE SPACED • .5 INCH MARGINS • 3-4 PAGES LONG
