Recently the Governor of New Mexico signed a bill that provides funding to add additional days to the school calendar. This funding is intended to address the loss of learning opportunities and instructional support experienced during the pandemic. Carlsbad Municipal Schools is evaluating the supports available under this funding. To access the funding the school district must add instructional days to the calendar.
