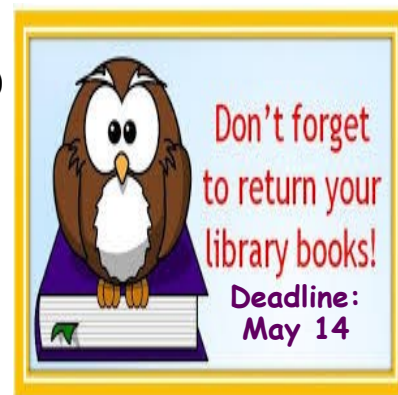

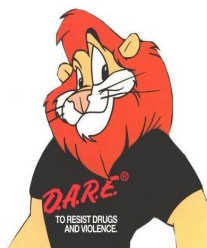

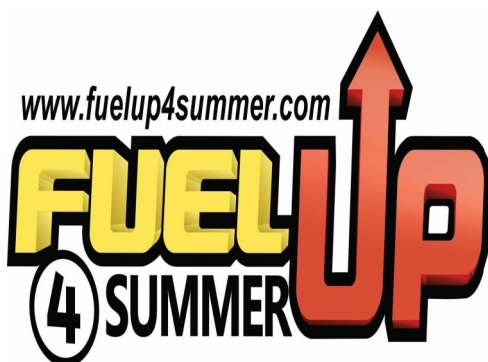


Summer Meals Begin on Tuesday, June 1 Monday-Friday

Fourth grade students recently celebrated Arbor Day by planting trees in the Haven community. Arbor Day was started in 1874 by J. Sterling Morton. On that first Arbor Day, it is estimated that one million trees were planted in Nebraska. Now nearly every state celebrates this day and plants trees to replace those that have been cut down for various reasons.

Trees are important to people in many ways. Our Haven fourth graders named several reasons why we need trees. A few of these were for the wood, homes for animals, shade, oxygen, as a wind break, and to control erosion.

On Thursday, April 29th, the fourth graders walked to a residence in Haven and listened to this information about Arbor Day from Haven Tree Board member, Stephanie Carlson. They then helped Dennis Carlson plant two new crabapple trees at this residence. Each student added a shovelful of dirt to complete the tree planting.
