

Annual Budget Vote and Election 2021

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Can I vote by absentee ballot?

- Yes, but the reason for the request must be acceptable per law. See the absentee ballot application on our website at www.westfieldcsd.org/browse/195632. The acceptable reasons are listed on the application.

2. If I am not a registered voter can I still vote?

- Yes, please have a photo ID on hand (some examples are a driver's license, passport, military ID.) at the voting location.

3. Am I required to wear a mask when I vote?

- Yes, all voters must wear an acceptable mask that covers both the nose and mouth and adhere to all COVID-19 safety measures.

4. I am a member of the military (or family member) and would like to vote by absentee ballot. What is the process?

6. What are the qualifications to vote?

- Citizen of the United States; and
- At least 18 years old; and
- A resident of the school district for at least 30 days prior to the meeting at which the person would like to vote; and
- Who is not otherwise prohibited from voting under the provisions of section 5-106 of the Election Law
