### Development of 20-21 Goals

Mrs. Dailer presented four goals for the LSIC's consideration

1. Use of new data tools to determine student knowledge & growth in Math & ELA

*Newly developed Nine Week Exams, addition of Exact Path to Test Strategies, regular review of data, change to exam policy for all students to be tested*

2. Review & modify current GPA system

*Continued issues with GPA equity as well as effects of limiting Pass/Fail (Audit Your "A") credits Leadership Team and Curriculum Focus Group working on same goal*

3. Review & modify current Nine Week Exam process

*Mrs. Dailer will present to BOE to remove Exam Exemption policy this evening*

*No exam exemptions will support Goal 1 as well as better prepare students for college*

*Need to further discuss comprehensive exams & percentage of grade*

4. Incorporate additional ABAR (anti-racist, anti-bias) education

*Per OCS "Together We Stand" as well as cooperative with Wheeling Central & The Linsly School's Social Justice Allies of Wheeling*

### Vote on 2510 Waiver

Mrs. Dailer presented OCS Waiver request for Policy 2510, Section 9.1.h Uniform Grading

- Discussion on the history of Audit Your "A" as well as the impact it has on elective courses participation, specifically Career Technical and Fine & Performing Arts
- It is understood that this Audit Your "A" would be phased out starting with the class of 2025 and is one piece of our larger Goal 2 – Review & Modify current GPA system.
