Who Qualifies?

• Current Kindergarten - 4th Graders who have received services through 21st Century, ELL, LAP, Title I, or Special Education and qualify for LAP or ELL services.

When and Where?

- Monday through Friday June 28th through July 23nd
- Holiday No Summer School July 5th
- Schools (Cascade Elementary, Grove Elementary, Liberty Elementary and Quil Ceda Tulalip Elementary) Your student will be assigned a school based on bussing schedules from your address. Cascade Cascade and Pinewood

What does it cost?

• Summer Success Program is free for families, paid through state and federal grants and in collaboration with the Washington Alliance for Better Schools (WABS) program.

What about meals and transportation?

- Breakfast and lunch are included for all students.
- Transportation will be provided If assigned school is not within walking distance from your home.
- If you currently reside outside of the district boundaries, transportation to summer school will be the family's responsibility.

Why should my child attend?

- Your child will receive 95 hours of small group focused instruction in math, reading and writing, including enrichment programming from 21st Century. We know that specific, focused instruction for struggling students is critical to on-going academic success.
- 21st Century provides fun, engaging enrichment programming for students, including social-emotional learning, art, music, movement, and field trips.
- Please commit to having your child attend all four weeks! This is targeted instruction to help your student be better prepared for 2021 2022.
- Students who miss more than three (3) days will be dropped from the program dropped from the Marysville School District Program. If you can not attend on Fridays, this will not count as an absence.

How do I register my student and when are the registration forms due?
