Winter Is Here!

As we all know, the weather can change quickly in our area. During winter months, the transportation department must be prepared for rain, fog, snow, and ice.

We ask that children and parents are patient when waiting for buses to arrive at bus stops during Winter months. Many contributing factors can make buses run late. Children should always arrive no less than 5 minutes before the bus is scheduled to arrive, and wait at least 15 minutes before returning home.

Fog is a condition that could affect transportation. State law requires 200 feet visibility for a driver to continue to drive the route. Unfortunately, this is not possible to predict. If your child returns home, call the transportation office at 622-6244 ext. 6010.

Schools open with “limited service” is something you may hear on a news bulletin. This will occur when roads are impassable due to rain, fog, snow, ice, road closure, etc.
