Blennerhassett Middle School's Junior Thespian Troupe will perform "Shrek the Musical Jr." beginning today at 7 p.m.

The musical adaptation of the hit movie and book follows the adventures of Shrek (Zane VanFossen), a grumpy ogre who finds himself the unlikely rescuer of a Princess Fiona (Ali Evans) who is more than she appears to be, and his loyal but very chatty sidekick Donkey, (Andrew Hanna).
