To Lebanon CUSD #9 Families,

The Lebanon Community Unit School District will be offering an online-based, virtual summer school for any K-12 students who are in need of credit/class recovery, as well as a summer “boost” in various skill sets. The online platform we will be utilizing for our summer school is Educere. Families are strongly encouraged to take advantage of this educational opportunity for any students who have failed to meet district requirements to advance to the next grade level, or to recover some classes they have failed in the past.


This online platform will allow students to complete coursework online, in 5-6 weeks over the summer. The timeline for completion is dependent upon the amount of work per day a student completes. Summer courses are set to start in early June.

There are fees for using Educere summer school programming. When enrolled, regular pay families will be charged \$50 per class, while free and reduced families will be charged \$25 per class. If your student fails to successfully complete their summer school coursework, the student’s family will be billed to pay their summer school fees. **IF SUMMER CLASSES ARE SUCCESSFULLY PASSED AND COMPLETED, THE SCHOOL DISTRICT WILL WAIVE ALL ASSESSED FEES FOR THE ENTIRE COST OF CREDIT RECOVERY OR BOOST PROGRAMS.** Therefore, if students work to complete and pass classes, all fees will be waived and invoices for classes removed and paid by Lebanon CUSD #9.

Contact the school office if you are interested in enrolling and we will assist you in the process.

Please note that students will have access to the courses in a day or two after they have been registered.
